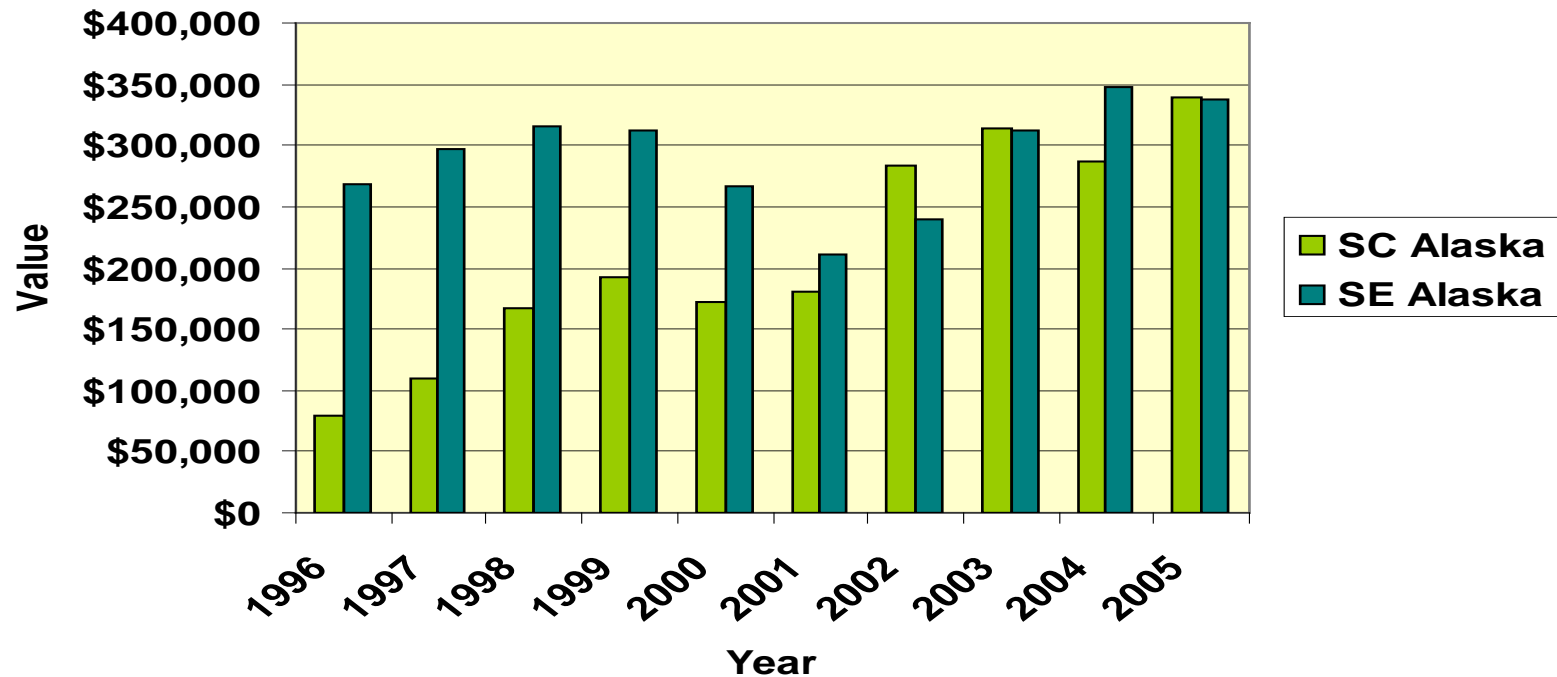

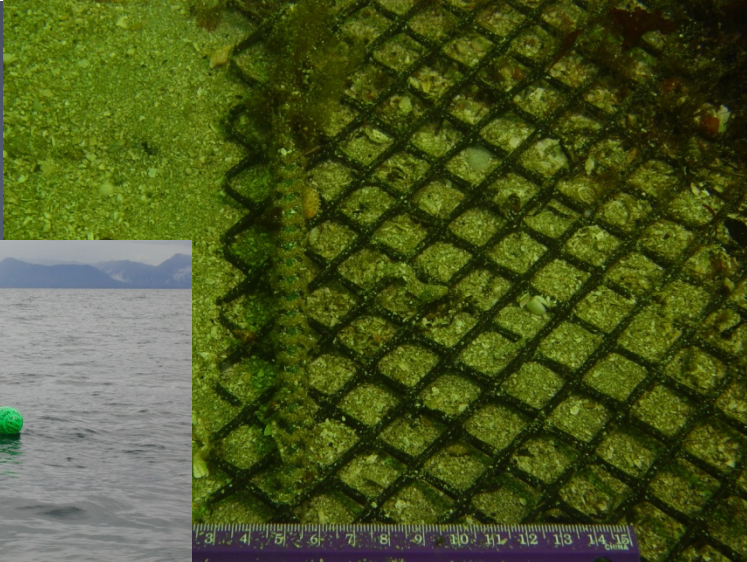

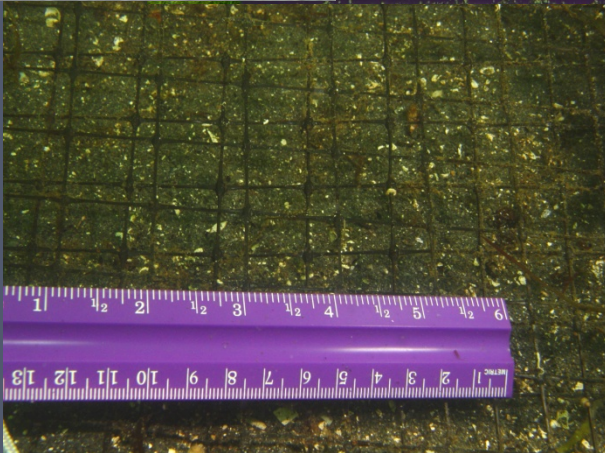

Aquatic Farm Batch Process Application Period

- Opening Every Two Years
- Now Accepting Applications
- Ends April 30, 2007
- Final Decisions within 9 to 15 months

Over-The-Counter Method

- Apply anytime
- Designated areas (HB208)
 - Suspended culture: 76 areas = 710 acres
 - Intertidal culture: 8 areas = 55 acres
- Pre-authorized Sites
 - Suspended culture: 11 sites = 45 acres
