EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the resident and nonresident goat hunting seasons in the Lutak Inlet-Chilkoot Lake portion of hunt area RG023 between Taiyasanka Harbor and the northern end of Chilkoot Lake. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Friday, November 4, 2011.

REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting goat in Unit 1(D):

Unit 1(D), that portion east of Lutak Inlet and Chilkoot Lake between Taiyasanka Harbor and the 4300 foot saddle east of the northern end of Chilkoot Lake	Sept. 15–Nov. 4 (General hunt only)	Sept. 15–Nov. 4

1 goat by registration permit only.

The remainder of Unit 1D mountain goat seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

Biologists have set a guideline harvest objective of 2-3 points (male goats=1 point & female goats=2 points) for the Lutak Inlet-Chilkoot Lake hunt area between Taiyasanka Harbor and the northern end of Chilkoot Lake. As of Thursday, November 3, 2011, 3 male goats have been harvested in this area, for a total of 3 points. Due to the vulnerability of goats in this area, and because the guideline harvest level has been met, an emergency order (01-18-11) is being issued effective at 11:59 pm, Friday, November 4, 2011.
