EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state drawing permit hunt DM167 for antlered moose in Game Management Unit 6(C). All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 6 are unaffected by this emergency order.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 85.045(4), Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

JUSTIFICATION:

Thirteen DM167 permits were issued but subsequently ADFG set a reduced harvest quota of 20 bull moose in Game Management Unit 6(C), including 5 bulls taken under state DM167 and 15 bulls taken under a federal subsistence drawing hunt. Additional harvest would increase the state harvest beyond 25% of total bull harvest in Unit 6C set under federal hunting regulations.
