- WHEREAS, to provide the sustained yield of our natural resources; and
- WHEREAS, the need to avoid disruption of non-subsistence harvest opportunities; and
- WHEREAS, to protect the viability of the guide industry; and
- WHEREAS, in support of return of management of marine mammals to the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS, harvests by guided hunters of several important big game animals are relatively predictable and manageable under the current guiding regulations, but could be unpredictable and locally damaging if such regulations are voided,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Game is in support of retention of the Guide Board.
