2016 Kuskokwim River Salmon Fishery News Release #3 Emergency Orders; #3-S-WR-02-16, #3-S-WR-03-16

This is an announcement from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in Bethel for subsistence fishermen in the Kuskokwim Area. Effective 12:00 p.m. Sunday, June 12, 2016 Emergency Order #3-S-WR-01-16 is rescinded.

Federal Special Action

Management of subsistence fishery from the mouth of the Kuskokwim River to the Yukon Delta NWR boundary at Aniak (defined as the Federal Conservation Unit) is under authority of the Federal Inseason Manager. For information regarding subsistence fishing within this area please contact Ray Born at 907-543-1003.

From the Yukon Delta NWR boundary at Aniak to the Holitna River mouth: Section 4

Subsistence fishing with 6-inch or less mesh gillnets, not to exceed 25 fathoms, will be allowed for 48 hours from 12:00 p.m. noon, Sunday, June 12 until 12:00 p.m. noon, Tuesday, June 14, 2016.

Additional opportunity will be announced contingent on Chinook salmon run strength indicators.

As previously announced, subsistence fishing with gillnets remains closed in the Aniak River.

From the Holitna River mouth to the headwaters of the Kuskokwim River: Section 5

Subsistence fishing with 6-inch or less mesh gillnets will be allowed from 12:00 p.m. noon, Sunday, June 12 until further notice.

Additional subsistence fishing gear for both sections 4 and 5:

Chinook salmon may be retained if caught with fish wheels, dip nets, beach seines, and hook and line beginning 12:00 p.m. noon, Sunday, June 12 until further notice.
