EXPLANATION:

This emergency order adds Leech, Summit, and Zero lakes to the list of lakes stocked with hatchery fish. The bag and possession limit for rainbow trout is 5 fish, of which only one may be 20 inches or greater in length. The bag and possession limit for Arctic grayling is 5 fish, no size limit.

Under the authority of 16.05.060(a) the provisions of 5 AAC 60.120 (3)(B) the following lakes are added to the stocked lakes listing. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Saturday, June 19 through 11:59 p.m. Thursday, December 31, 2020:

5 AAC 60.120. General provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the Knik Arm Drainages Area.

- (3) rainbow/steelhead trout
 - (B) may be taken in stocked lakes and ponds from January 1 December 31; bag and possession limit of five fish, of which only one may be 20 inches or greater in length; for the purposes of this subparagraph, "stocked lakes and ponds" include Barley Lake, Bear Paw Lake, Bench Lake, Beverly Lake, Big Beaver Lake, Blair Lake, Brocker Lake, Bruce Lake, Buck Lake, Canoe Lake, Carpenter Lake, Coyote Lake, Dawn Lake, Diamond Lake, Echo Lake (Kepler/Bradley), Farmer Lake, Finger Lake, Florence Lake, Golden Lake, Goober Lake, Homestead Lake, Honeybee Lake, Ida Lake, Irene Lake, Kepler/Bradley Lakes, Klaire Lake, Kalmbach Lake, Knik Lake, Knob Lake, Lalen Lake, Leech Lake, Little Beaver Lake, Little Lonely Lake, Loberg (Junction Lake), Long Lake (MP 86 Glenn HWY), Loon Lake, Lorraine Lake, Lucille Lake, Lynne Lake, Marion Lake, Matanuska Lake, Meirs Lake, Memory Lake, Morvro Lake, North Knob Lake, North Rolly Lake, Prator Lake, Ravine Lake, Reed Lake, Reflections Lake, Rhein Lake, Rocky Lake, Ruby Lake, Rush Lake, Seventeenmile Lake, Seymour Lake, Slipper (Eska) Lake, South Rolly Lake, Summit Lake, Tanaina Lake, Twin Island Lake, Vera Lake, Victor Lake, Visnaw Lake, Walby Lake, Weiner Lake, West Beaver Lake, Wolf Lake and Zero Lake;
- (5) Arctic grayling may be taken in
 - (B) stocked lakes and ponds from January 1 December 31; bag and possession limit of five fish; no size limit; for the purpose of this subparagraph, "stocked lakes and ponds" has the same meaning given in (3)(B) of this section;

JUSTIFICATION:

Recently, Leech lake was stocked with 484 catchable rainbow trout, Zero Lake with 3,722 rainbow trout fingerling, and Summit Lake with 500 catchable Arctic grayling. Therefore, it is justified to increase the bag and possession limits on these lakes to match those of other stocked lakes. The stocking program provides alternative opportunities for anglers that might otherwise direct their efforts toward native fish that are vulnerable to overfishing.
