# **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order rescinds Emergency Order No. 1-RS-F-24-24, issued July 16, 2024. Emergency Order No. 1-RS-F-24-24 prohibited sockeye salmon retention in Chilkoot Lake and Chilkoot River. Effective 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, August 7, 2024, the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon in the Chilkoot River and Chilkoot Lake will be six fish, 16 inches or greater in length.

# **REGULATION:**

Emergency Order No. 1-RS-F-24-24 is rescinded.

## **JUSTIFICATION:**

The run of sockeye salmon to Chilkoot Lake and River is projected to be within the escapement goal range (38,000 – 86,000 fish). Through August 5, 50,017 fish have passed the weir. On average 73% of the run has passed through the weir by this date. Therefore, restrictions to increase sockeye salmon escapement to the Chilkoot drainage are no longer necessary.

PREVIOUS EMERGENCY ORDERS AFFECTED: Emergency Order No. 1-RS-F-24-24, issued July 16, 2024, which prohibited the retention of sockeye salmon in the Chilkoot River and Chilkoot Lake is rescinded.
