

Stock Transport Permit Instructions

When filling out the Aquatic Farm Stock Transport Permit application please use the provided fillable Word document or the pdf version.

The completed application can be submitted through the following methods:

Applicant Information:

Applicant information should correspond with your operation permit contact information. List the email that you wish the approved permit to be sent to.

Project Information:

A separate application must be submitted for each change in species, source, and receiving location.

Is the source of the stock currently listed as an approved/certified seed source? Check the online provider list to check the most updated seed source list and their expiration dates.

- a. If YES, select one of the facilities listed or select "other" and provide the facility name.
- b. If NO, (for aquatic plants or other sources not listed on the approved or certified seed source list) select one of the facilities listed or "other" and provide the facility name.

Required stock information:

- Select life stage
- List size range in millimeters
- Max number requested must be total number of organisms requested for the duration of the permit. If you are provided with spores/ft and total number of feet from the seed provider, please calculate the approximate number of organisms.
- Estimated ship date should include a range of months and the year requested
- Broodstock origin must include the hatchery and bay of origin from which the seed originated. For aquatic plants, additional documents are required. 1. A map must be provided showing distance from broodstock collection to farm location and 2. A table showing the number of contributing broodstock individuals.

Transport TO:

- Provide the full name of the farm, nursery, or hatchery the organisms are being transported to.
- Provide ADF&G operation permit number for the site in which the organisms are going to. (Not the DNR lease number).
- Provide the water body or location to which the organisms will be transported to.
