This summary of actions is for information purposes only and not intended to detail, reflect or fully interpret reasons for Board actions. *No Action (9)=No action due to action taken on Proposal 9.

PROPOSAL NO. 1 ACTION:

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(1). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. In Unit 6, extend the season to Dec. 1-Apr. 30 and increase the bag limit for beaver to unlimited.

AMENDMENT: DISCUSSION:

PROPOSAL NO. 2 ACTION: Passed as Amended: 7-0-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(1). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Housekeeping proposal to align the existing regulations governing trapping seasons and bag limits for beaver in Unit 9B and 17.

AMENDMENT A. To extend the season to March 31 in Unit 17 to align it with the adjoining Unit 9 season and to include extension of the land otter season to March 31.

DISCUSSION: This staff-generated proposal is a housekeeping measure to reflect new methods and means regulations (using firearms) during open season dates April 15-May 31, as passed previously. Includes the extension of season dates to land otter to make it legal means of take for otter caught in beaver sets. The Board agreed with the basic intent of cleaning up the existing regulations.

PROPOSAL NO. 3 ACTION: Passes: 7-0-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(1). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Extend beaver trapping season in Unit 16B to open Oct. 1 and close May 15.

AMENDMENT: RC 64 substitute language in 3A changes season dates.

DISCUSSION: Author wants to control pike population which is not intent of the Board. Department identifies no biological concern if season is extended. This action would increase opportunity for harvest of an underutilized resource.

PROPOSAL NO. 4 ACTION: Fails: 0-7-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(1). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Close the Little Susitna River drainage within the Hatcher Pass management area to beaver trapping.

AMENDMENT: None

DISCUSSION: There are problem beaver every year, a disincentive for closing the season. Author would be happy with a smaller area for instance Section 8-1/2 to 14.

PROPOSAL NO. 5 ACTION: Fails 0-7-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(5). FUR BEARER TRAPPING and 5 AAC 85.060(4). Limit the season for lynx to 1 lynx per year, or close the season in Unit 15.

AMENDMENT: None

DISCUSSION: Lynx bag limits are self-regulating. There is enough data to warrant this action. Since lynx opulations are cyclic, there is bound to be a closure but unnecessary at this time.

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(6). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Amend season for taking marten in Units

7, 8, and 15 to Nov. 10 - Dec. 31, with a bag limit of 5.

DISCUSSION: There is no conservation concern, with very little trapping pressure. Martin migrate any time

there is lower density surrounding territory.

PROPOSAL NO. 8 **ACTION:** No Action (9)

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(12). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Impose a bag limit of 1 marmot per day in all areas north of Kachemak Bay in Unit 15C except close the season along the bluff above Homer and East End

Road between West Hill Road and the end of the bluff at Fritz Creek until the population recovers.

AMENDMENT: None DISCUSSION: None

ACTION: Fails: 0-7-0 PROPOSAL NO. 9

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(12). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Amend regulations for marmot and

squirrel as follows:

Unit 15C north of Kachemak Bay closed (15C needs to rebuild) Marmot

DISCUSSION: Marmot were here historically but not now, but probably due to human development, not human harvest. Liberal bag limit is directed toward pest species, (for example: squirrels.)

PROPOSAL NO. 10 **ACTION:** Passes as amended: 7-0-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(13). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Open the wolf trapping season Oct. 1 and extend the season to June 30.

AMENDMENT A: Season October 15-April 30. No bag limit. The portion of the season between October 15-November 9 and the month of April no steel traps or snares less than 3/32" in diameter will be allowed. Passses 7-0-0

DISCUSSION: These regulation changes will line up this season with season and bag limits of seasons in GMU 12 and are intended in part, to lessen enforcement problems caused by differing gear types.

ACTION: Fails 2-5-0 PROPOSAL NO. 11

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 84.270(13). FUR BEARER TRAPPING and 5 AAC 85.056(2). HUNTING

SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR WOLF. Close Unit 13E to wolf trapping and wolf hunting.

AMENDMENT A: As read by Streveler from RC 78. Close the following area to wolf trapping and wolf hunting: Western limit would extend from Cantwell to Lignite, following the Denali National Park and reserve boundary. The southern boundary would extend from Cantwell eastward along the Denali Hwy. Approximately ten miles east of the Georges park hwy Junction. The eastern boundary would extend north from the Denali Hwy east of Reindeer hills, crossing Pyramid Mountain, Dora Peak, Usibelli, and Walker

dome. The northern boundary would extend westward from Walker dome, crossing Lignite air strip, to the Denali Park and Preserve boundary. Draft wording. Passes 6-1-0

DISCUSSION: Reference to RC 78, 93 Department identifies a decline not completely due to harvest by numans. Suggest compensation to trappers who are precluded from trapping due to this action. Movement in and out of the park boundaries must be considered. This proposed amendment refers to GMU 20 and in small part to GMU 13 and should be duly noticed and dealt with at next years meeting. A two-year sunset was suggested.

PROPOSAL NO. 12 ACTION: Fails: 0-7-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 85.045(14). FUR BEARER TRAPPING. Change the wolverine trapping season to

Nov. 10 - Jan. 31 with a bag limit of 2.

AMENDMENT: None

DISCUSSION: This could necessitate a subsistence action for allowable harvest. Wolverine populations are hard to survey and there is a lack of data.

PROPOSAL NO. 13 ACTION:

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 92.550. AREAS CLOSED TO TRAPPING. Close trapping seasons in the following areas in Unit 6D: All land within one mile of the coastline of Blackstone Bay, Passage Canal, and Port Wells (Including Harriman Fiord).

AMENDMENT: DISCUSSION:

PROPOSAL NO. 14 ACTION: Fails 0-7-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 92.550. AREAS CLOSED TO TRAPPING. Close trapping season in the following areas: All drainages leading into Turnagain Arm; all land within two miles of any publicly owned road within Unit 7; and all land within one mile of the following designated trails: The Resurrection Pass trail in its entirety from Hope to Seward, the Devils Pass trail, the Johnson Pass trail, the Cresent Lake trail, the Carter Lake trail, the Ptarmigan Creek trail, the Lost Lake trail, the Russian Lake trails (i.e. from both ends), all land within one mile of the coastline of Resurrection and Aialik Bays (including the coastline between these two bays), all land within five miles of the Grandview stop on the Alaska Railroad.

AMENDMENT: None

DISCUSSION: There is no conservation concern, and the Board does not want to create one by eliminating trapping in the entire area.

PROPOSAL NO. 15 ACTION: Fails: 0-7-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 92.550(3). AREAS CLOSED TO TRAPPING. Close trapping seasons in the following areas: All drainage leading into Eklutna Lake and the Eklutna River, all drainages leading into Peters creek, all drainages leading into Eagle River, all drainages leading into Ship Creek, all drainages leading into Tumagain Arm, all drainages leading into Anchorage Management Area, all of the Hatcher Pass public use area, all land within two miles of any publicly owned road within Unit 14C. That portion of the Chugach State Park which is not closed to trapping should be open to trapping under Unit 14C season and bag limits, except that there should be no trapping of wolves, wolverine, land otter, beaver, or lynx permitted.

AMENDMENT: None

DISCUSSION: This proposes wide spread generic change that would eliminate trapping in most of 14C.

PROPOSAL NO. 16 ACTION: Passes as Amended: 7-0-0

DESCRIPTION: 5 AAC 85.010(1). HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR BISON. Require the nunters obtain a limited use permit from Ahtna, Inc. before they obtain a bison hunt permit from the state. The fee for the permit is \$2,000.

AMENDMENT A: Proposal 16A. Substitute language as found in RC 58, cleaning up the description of the area and the season date changes.

DISCUSSION: The Board may not delegate its authority to another agency (Ahtna) to administer this permit hunt. An alternate list of permittees was discussed to maximize utilization of available permits. Successful permittees will need to get permission from the landowner and there will be a deadline for subscribing to the hunt. The order of how to administer this hunt is important.

Changes in the Alaska Game Regulations

Effective July 1, 1999

This is a summary of some of the most significant regulation changes adopted by the Alaska Board of Game during the past year. By comparing this to your **Alaska State Hunting Regulations No. 39** you will have a good idea of what to expect in the upcoming season. Unless otherwise noted, none of these changes goes into effect until July 1.

This is **NOT** designed to be a substitute for the 1999-2000 regulations book, No. 40, which will be available around June 1. It is important to check the new regulations book before going afield.

Newspaper supplements describing drawing and Tier II subsistence permit hunts are <u>online</u>. Permit applications must be postmarked no later than May 31.

BISON

Created two new drawing bison hunts in Units 11 and 13.

CARIBOU

- Shortened the Tier II caribou hunt in Unit 13 by 10 days, starting Aug. 10 instead of Aug. 1; changed bag limit from one bull to one caribou; eliminated Tier I hunt,
- Extended the season for the caribou drawing hunt in the Kenai Mountains in Unit 7 to Aug. 10- Dec. 31, and increased number of permits.
- Created a new drawing permit hunt, two-cow-caribou bag limit in Killey River, Unit 15B East, season Aug. 10-Oct, 10.
- Reduced caribou bag limit for both resident and nonresident hunters in 9A and portion of 9C (Alagnak River drainage) from four caribou to one, season Aug. 1-Mar. 31.
- Established Tier II caribou hunt in remainder of 9C, and Unit 9E; one caribou by Tier II permit, season in 9C Aug. 10- Sept. 20 and Nov. 15-Feb. 28, in 9E Aug. 10- Sept. 20 and Nov. 1-April 30.
- Opened resident general season in Unit 9D for one caribou Sept. 1-20 or Nov. 15-March 31, and nonresident registration hunt for one bull Sept. 10-25.

DEER

Increased resident bag limit in Unit 6 from four deer to five.

MOOSE

- Extended fall moose hunts (general season and drawing) in Units 14A, B, and remainder of 14C and 16A from Sept. 20 to Sept. 25; shortened the winter spike-fork hunt in the same areas by starting them Dec. 5 instead of Nov. 20.
- Shortened moose season in **Unit 13**, opening Sept. 1 instead of Aug. 20; changed Tier II season dates to Aug. 15-31.
- Created new spike-fork/ 50-inch drawing permit hunt in portions of Units 7 and Unit 15, Oct. 20-Nov.
 20.
- Changed antierless moose season in Unit 15C to coincide with the general season, Aug 20-Sept. 20.
- Opened registration hunt for any moose on Kalgin Island, Aug. 20-Sept. 30.
