NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE ALASKA BOARD OF GAME AND MEETING OF THE ALASKA BOARD OF GAME

The Alaska Board of Game proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 5 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with the use and taking of game in Game Management Unit 23, including

5 AAC 85.025, Hunting seasons and bag limits for caribou, is proposed to be changed regarding the hunting seasons and bag limits for caribou in Unit 23 in defined guide-outfitter guide use areas.

5 AAC 92.540, Controlled use areas, is proposed to be changed regarding the dates for the use of aircraft in any manner for big game hunting in the Noatak Controlled Use Area in Unit 23.

You may comment on the proposed regulation changes, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the changes, by submitting written comments to the Alaska Board of Game, Boards Support Section at P.O. Box 115526, Juneau, AK 99811-5526, or by fax to (907) 465-6094. The comments must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. June 27, 2008.** Written comments received are public records and are subject to public inspection. Written comments over 100 single-sided or 50 double-sided pages in length from any one individual or group will not be accepted.

Notice is given that the Alaska Board of Game (board) will consider these proposed regulation changes at a special teleconference meeting scheduled for Wednesday, July 2, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. At this meeting, the board also intends to make emergency regulations permanent dealing with predator control implementation plans as follows:

- 1. Wolf control programs in Units 12, 16(A) and (B), 20(B), 20(D), 20(E), and 25(C).
- 2. Brown bear control program in Unit 20(E).
- 3. Black bear control program in Units 16(A) and (B).

The board adopted these emergency regulations on March 21, 2008 as a result of a court order. The board issued a **NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS** regarding the emergency regulations on March 26, 2008. The emergency regulations took effect March 21, 2008 and will expire July 18, 2008, unless made permanent.

The board will not be taking oral public testimony during the teleconference. The meeting is open to the public.
