





BROWN BEAR


- Variable distribution in Unit
- Restricted almost entirely to mainland...maybe!
- Berners Bay research
- Mean annual harvest: 5 bears (2002-2011)
 - 9% Hunter success rate
 - 81% Males
- Proposal 3 & 4

- Mean annual harvest: 97 (2002-2011)




- Avg. 163 hunters/year (range 140-190)
- Avg. annual success rate: 43%
- Avg. days/successful hunter: 4.2 (range 4-5.1)

Unit 1C Black Bear Harvest by Residency 2002-2011




SITKA BLACK-TAILED DEER

- Mean annual harvest: 368 (2002-2011)
 - 8-9 days/deer
 - 1.5 deer/successful hunter
- Most abundant on islands; present on mainland
- Significant winter mortality 2006-2007
- Proposal 1



MOOSE

Four management populations

- Gustavus
 - Registration permit/antler restriction
 - Drawing permit/antlerless moose
- Chilkat Range
 - Registration permit/any bull
- Taku River
 - Registration permit/any bull
- Berners Bay
 - Drawing permit/bull
 - Drawing permit/antlerless

Gustavus Bull Moose Hunt

- Any bull (through 2008)
 - Difficult to manage
 - Season length ranged from 30 days to 6 hours
- 2009-2010: antler restriction
 - 2009: 14 bulls & 30 days
 - 2010: 13 bulls & 20 days
 - 2011: 8 bulls & 30 Days
 - 2012: 9 bulls & 30 days
- 12% success (2009-2012)
- Proposal 9

MOOSE

Berners Bay Moose Hunts



- Any bull drawing permit
 - 6-10 permits annually (98-06)
 - 85% success

- Antlerless drawing permit
 - 2-10 permits (not issued every year)
 - 91% success

- Multiple severe winters beginning in 2006/2007 led to population decline




RM046 (Remainder of Unit 1C) Moose Hunts

- 17% success




Gustavus Moose harvest 2002-2011





MOUNTAIN GOAT



- **Mean annual harvest: 41
2002-2011**
 - 88 hunters/year
- **28 nonresident
hunters/year**
 - 83% success
- **60 resident hunters/year**
 - 28% success
- **89% of harvest is male
goats**


UNIT 1C MOUNTAIN GOAT MANAGEMENT OVERVIEW

- Goat hunts are managed by registration & drawing permits
- There are four registration permit hunts and one drawing permit hunt in Unit 1(C)...these have varying season dates
 - RG012 Oct. 1-Nov. 30
 - RG013 Aug. 1-Nov. 30
 - RG014 Aug. 1-Nov. 30 (archery only)
 - RG015 Sept. 1-Nov. 30
 - DG011 Oct. 1-Nov. 30
- Allowable harvest determined by aerial survey







GAME MANAGEMENT UNIT 1D

- Small subunit (~2850 mi²) bounded by public lands and Canada
- Accessible by road
- Human population is about 3,000 (Haines, Skagway, Klukwan)

DEER



- No open season
- Sullivan Island (1C) is closest open area
- Moose and goat are major source of meat in unit



- Proposal 16- (regional) modified bag limit





- Haines goat research

- Habitat selection
- Captured
25 Males / 15 Females
- Large Body Sizes
Avg. 307 lbs / 195 lbs
(Avg. age- 7 yrs)




MOOSE



- Tier II hunt with antler restriction
- Some local concern about status of herd & dissatisfaction with permit allocation
- Public meetings and education programs limit illegal bull harvest
- Surveys indicate stable population



Unit 1D Historical Moose Survey Data (1982-2012)




BLACK BEAR



- 79% of black bear harvest taken by residents
- Proposal 6 to change baiting season
- 34% of black bears reported taken over bait
- Important food source for subunit residents




BROWN BEAR

- Variety of public perceptions about bear population






FURBEARERS

- Variety of furbearer species
- On average 15 individual trappers (range: 11-20) sealed furs in each of the previous 5 years
- <10 furs per species sealed each year (1999-2011), except marten (avg. 110/yr)






BROWN BEAR

- Mean annual harvest (2002-2011)
 - Unit 5A: 21
 - Unit 5B: 7
 - 42% success unit wide
- 74% harvest by nonresidents
- High non-hunting mortality (1-14 bears/year)
- Yakutat & Malaspina Forelands research
- Proposal 5




Unit 5 Brown Bear Harvest 2002-2011

BLACK BEAR



- Mean annual harvest:
16 (2002-2011)
 - 56% resident hunter success
 - 44% nonresident hunter success
- Nearly 100% from 5A
- Annual glacier bear harvest: 2-3



- Avg. 14 hunters/year (range 11-20)
- Avg. annual success rate: 39%
- Avg. days/successful hunter: 4.4 (range 3.1-6.1)
- Avg. days/unsuccessful hunter: 6.4 (range 5.6-7.5)




SITKA BLACK-TAILED DEER

(2002-2011)
* 1 month buck only season
- Uncommon on mainland
- Deep snow and predation
limit deer
- Proposal 2



Unit 5A Deer Harvest & Hunter Effort 2001-2010





Yakutat Airport Snowfall 2001-2011




MOUNTAIN GOAT




- State and federal seasons

Unit 5 Mountain Goat Harvest 2002-2011




Unit 5 Mountain Goat Harvest by Residency 2002-2011
