

# Current Resident Season & Bag Limit – Remainder of Unit 18


- Aug. 1 Sept. 30: 2 moose; only 1 may be an antlered bull; no take of a calf or a cow accompanied by a calf
- Oct. 1 Nov. 30: 2 antlerless moose
- Dec. 1 Mar. 15: 2 moose




# Unit 18 Moose Population Status

- Population size within the Yukon River drainage is estimated to exceed 12,000 moose
- Recent 3-year period: 40% or greater twinning rates, 36-37 calf:100 adults recruitment rates
- Population still growing and harvests estimated to be well within sustained yield limits

 Sept. 1 – Sept. 14; one bull moose 50-inch antlers or 4 or more brow tines by registration permit (up to 10 permits may be issued)

- Oct. 1 Nov. 30; one bull moose
- Dec. 1 Dec. 31; one antlered bull moose

 Sept. 1 – Sept. 14; one bull moose 50-inch antlers or 4 or more brow tines by registration permit (no permits will be issued)



- Sept. 15 Sept. 30; one antlerless moose by registration permit
- → Jan. 1 Jan. 31; one antlered bull by registration permit; season announced by EO


➤ Sept. 1 – Sept .14; one bull moose 50-inch antlers or 4 or more brow tine by registration permit

#### **Unit 22C Moose Population Status**

- During RY2001 through RY2012, the population was above the published management objective of 450-525 moose
- GSPE population surveys completed during 2007 and 2012 indicated that the population size ranged from 620-670 moose
- ➤ Antlerless harvests of 8 24 moose reduced the population to 439 moose (2013 GSPE population survey)
- Permits were not issued for RY2014



- 2014 spring GSPE survey: 491 moose (GREEN BARS)
- 14% annual rate of decrease between 2011-2014 in Agiapuk River Drainage (Unit 22D Remainder).
- The next survey is scheduled for February 2017.



- RY2006 RY2014: Average reported bull harvest = 20 bulls/year
- RY2006 RY2014:
  Average reported antlerless harvest = 1 antlerless /year








- ANS: 325 400 moose
- Intensive Mgmt. Objectives: 3,500 9,200 moose
  (population size) & 210 920 moose (harvest objective)

- Bag Limit: One antlerless moose by registration permit (RM880)

  - -- Unit 23: 8 years
  - -- Unit 26A: 3 years
