- Concern over accidental cow harvest.



- Reducing bear density enough to increase moose population would require very high harvest.
 - Including sows and cubs
- Contrary to our management objective for bears:
 - High bear density
 - Harvest of 60% males; 50 over 7 years of age.
- Probably unattainable
 - Even with nonresidents included

- Local residents have opportunities to take bears in or near town:
 - RB525 was designed to address problem bears in villages.
 - Near-village hunt open year round.
 - No locking-tag required.
 - RB502 Subsistence hunt open Sep-May, meat salvage required. No locking-tag required.

- Drawing Permit Hunt DB375 and DB376
 - Board increased permits from 16 to 25 in 2014.
- Harvest was 6 13 bears during last 10 years.



- The proposed change would not significantly affect harvest level.
- Weather often hampers hunting activity and logistics. Season extension could improve quality of hunt.
- Regulation would align spring season with Unit 9.
