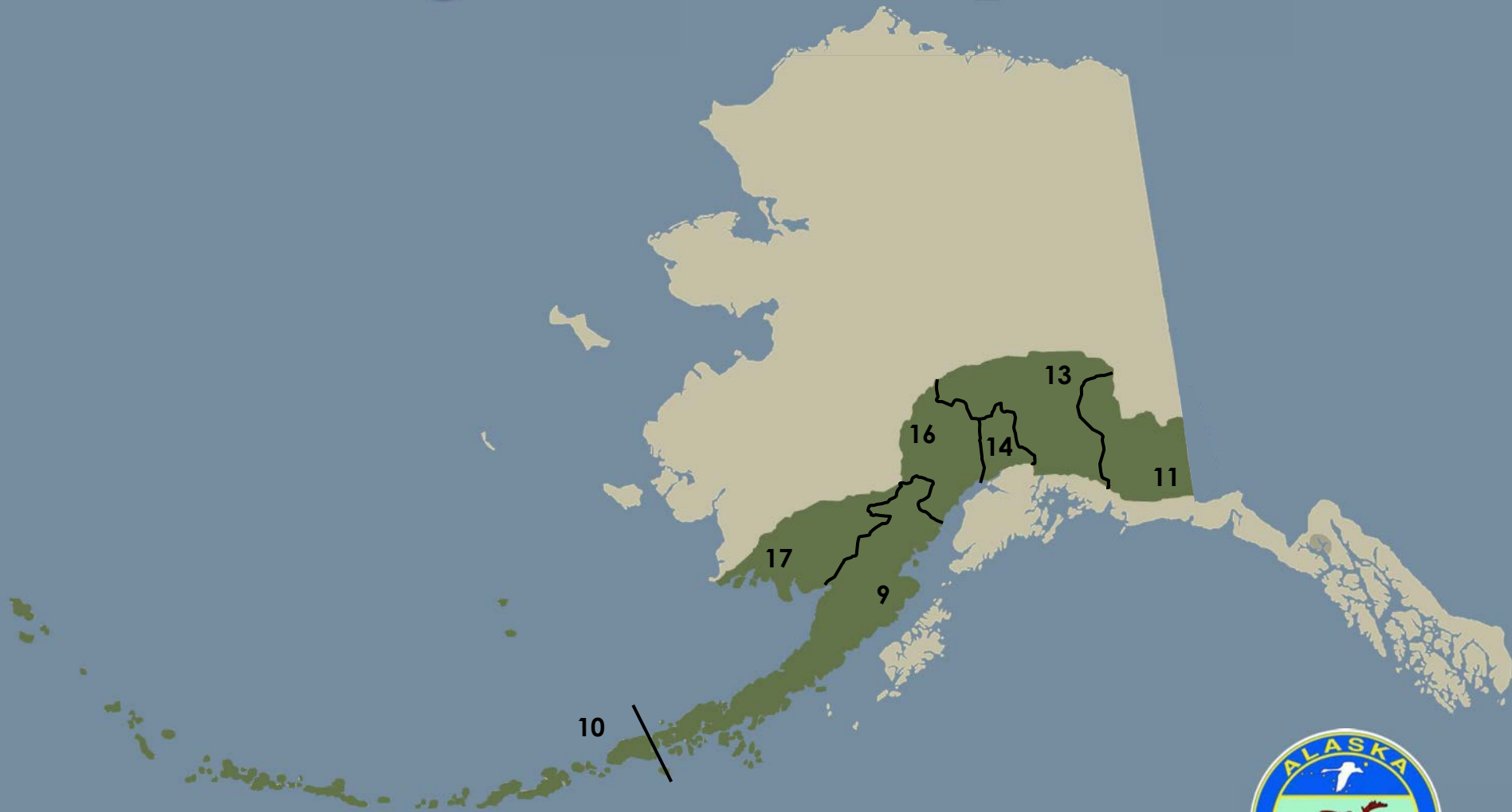

# Proposal 125

## Region IV - Moose

Proposed by Alaska Bowhunters Assoc.

### Effect of Proposal :

**Modify general season moose hunts in Region IV**

1. **Create an archery-only season for moose occurring after the closure of the general season hunt.**
2. **Archery season would be 7 days long.**

### Recommendation :

**NEUTRAL - allocation.**

**OPPOSED - to the potential increase in harvest in Units 13, 14, and 17.**

# Proposal 126

## Region IV – Brown Bear

Proposed by the department

### Effect of Proposal :

**Reauthorize all brown bear tag fee exemptions in  
Region IV**

**1. Opportunistic Harvest:**

- Unit 9 & 10 – within 2.5 mile radius of communities
- Units 13 & 16, excluding Denali State Park
- Unit 11 & 17

**2. Subsistence Harvest:**

- Units 9B & 17
- Unit 9E, specified portion draining into the Pacific

**Recommendation : SUPPORT**

# Proposal 127

## Region IV – Brown Bear

Proposed by Anchorage AC

### Effect of Proposal :

**Modify salvage requirements**

**Remove the salvage requirement for brown bears taken over bait.**

**Recommendation : OPPOSED – Statewide regulation**

# Proposal 128

## Region IV – Brown Bear

Proposed by public

### Effect of Proposal :

#### Modify salvage requirements

1. Remove the salvage requirement for brown bears taken over bait.
2. Aligns salvage requirements with black bears.

### Recommendation :

**TAKE NO ACTION** - based on action taken proposal 127.

**OPPOSED** - to the alignment of black and brown bear salvage requirement in Unit 13D.

# Proposal 129

## Region IV - Baiting

Proposed by public

### Effect of Proposal :

**Modify bear baiting requirement**

**Remove the requirement to clean up contaminated soil from bear bait sites**

**Recommendation : OPPOSED – Statewide regulation**

# Proposal 130

## Region IV – Wolf & coyote

Proposed by Mat-Valley AC

### Effect of Proposal :

#### Modify wolf and coyote hunts in Region IV

1. Allow resident and nonresidents to harvest wolves and coyotes using same day airborne hunting.
2. A person must be at least 300 feet from the airplane to harvest a wolf or coyote.

**Recommendation : TAKE NO ACTION**

# Proposal 132      Region IV – Migratory birds

Proposed by Sea Ducks Unlimited

## **Effect of Proposal :**

**Require the state to implement a reporting system for migratory birds in Region IV.**

**Recommendation : OPPOSED**



# Proposal 133    Region IV – Unlawful methods

Proposed by public

## Effect of Proposal :

**Allow the use of felt soled waders and wading boots.**

**Recommendation : OPPOSED – Statewide regulation**

# Proposal 134 Region IV – Hunter Education

Proposed by public

## Effect of Proposal :

**Modify hunter education requirements**

**Create a crossbow hunter education and certification course.**

**Recommendation : OPPOSED – Statewide regulation**

# Proposal 135

Region IV - All big game

Proposed by public

## Effect of Proposal :

### Modify season dates and allocation

1. Add 5 days to all resident general hunting seasons.
2. Allocate 75% of drawing permits issued to residents.

**Recommendation : NEUTRAL**

# Proposal 136

## Region IV - All big game

Proposed by public

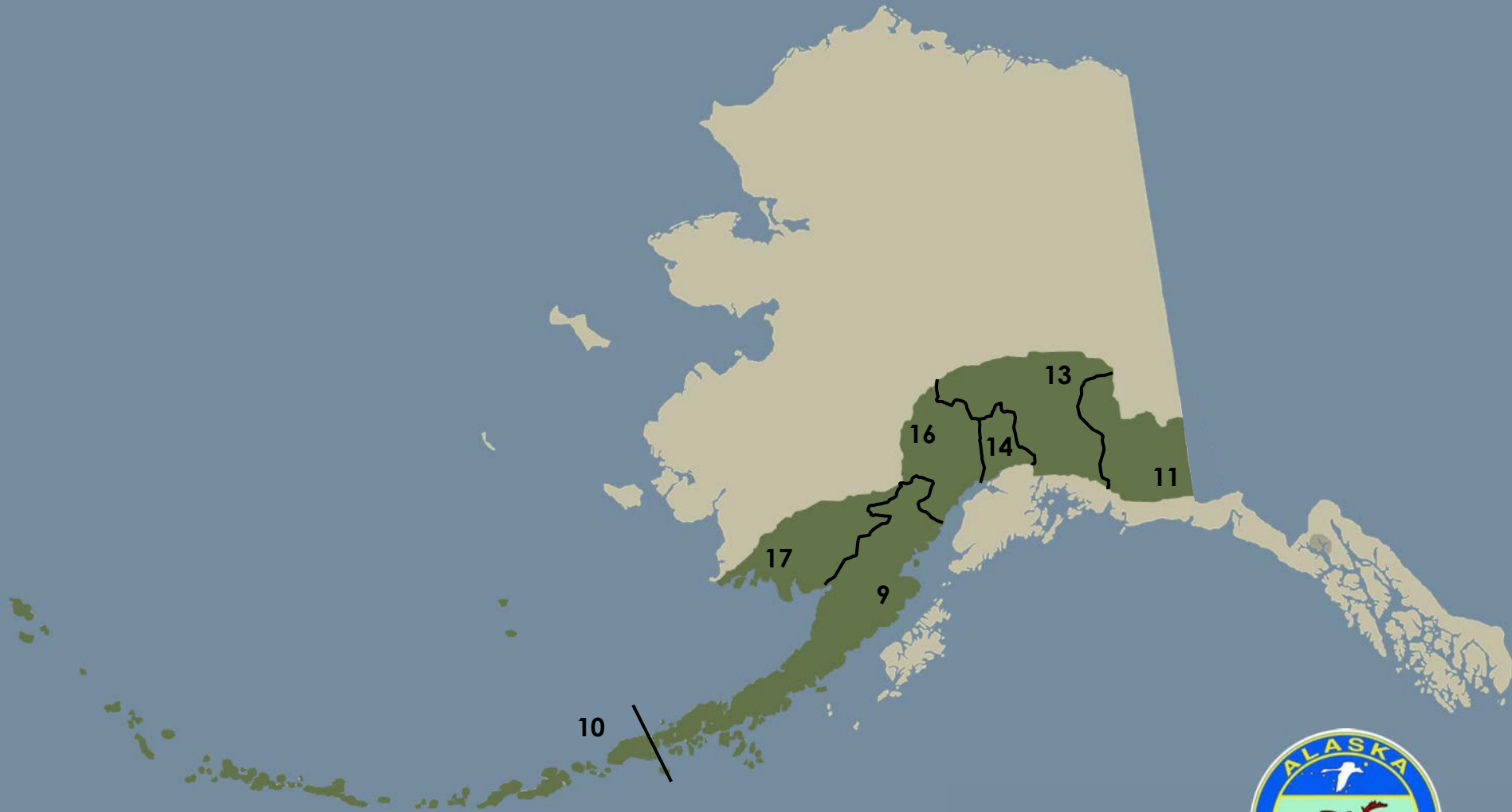
### Effect of Proposal :

#### Modify allocation of drawing permits

1. Allocate 90% of all drawing permits issued to residents
2. If remaining 10% allocated to nonresidents is undersubscribe, resident hunters would be rewarded permits.

**Recommendation : NEUTRAL**
