The Port Moller District will open to commercial herring fishing for 24 hours starting at 6:00 a.m. Sunday, May 17.

All herring **permit holders**, buyers and tender operators participating are **required to register** with the ADF&G in Port Moller prior to operations.

GHLs and maps of open sections are available at the Port Moller office and in the herring sac roe fishery harvest strategy found online for the 2020 season. Fishermen are urged to check with their market and test their catch prior to landing herring. Determining if size or roe quality meets processor standards is the responsibility of fishermen and industry.
