Lower Cook Inlet Salmon Fishery Announcement #9

SOUTHERN DISTRICT: Purse seine: In the Southern District, the following areas remain open to commercial common property purse seine salmon harvest on a Monday, Wednesday, and Friday schedule of 16-hour fishing periods from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM,

-the Halibut Cove Subdistrict, excluding Halibut Cove Lagoon,

-the Tutka Bay Subdistrict, excluding the Tutka Bay Hatchery special harvest area (SHA), -the China Poot Section including waters of the south arm of China Poot Bay west of 151° 15.53' west long., and waters of the north arm of China Poot Bay west of 151° 14.65' west long, and -the Neptune Bay Section excluding the Hazel Lake SHA.

Set gillnet: Waters of the Southern District identified in 5AAC 21.330(b)(1) remain open to commercial set gillnet harvest on a regular schedule of two 48-hour fishing periods per week beginning at 6:00 AM on Mondays and Thursdays as defined in 5AAC 21.320(a)(3). Harvest from fishing periods to date is shown below in Table 1,

Passage at the English Bay weir through June 29 is 6,552 sockeye salmon. This is above the desired range for this date of 2,732 - 6,147 fish in order to achieve the sustainable escapement goal of 6,000 - 13,500 fish on July 31 when the weir is removed.

KAMISHAK DISTRICT: The McNeil River Subdistrict, the Paint River Subdistrict, the Chenik Subdistrict, and Kirschner SHA remain closed to commercial salmon harvest until further notice. Other subdistricts of the Kamishak District as defined in 5AAC 21.299(e) remain open on a 7-days per week, 24-hour per day schedule.

EASTERN DISTRICT: The Resurrection Bay Subdistrict will be open from Monday, July 6 through Friday, July 10 for daily 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM commercial purse seine fishing periods.
