PORT MOLLER COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #8 **For Emergency Orders #4-FS-M-PM-8-20**

The Outer Port Heiden Section will open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 8 until 6:00 p.m. Friday, July 10. That portion of the Bear River Section located southwest of a 280° bearing perpendicular to the beach at the 2,000 yard northern regulatory marker at Sandy River located at 56° 15.26' N. lat., 160° 22.53' W. long will be closed to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 8 until further notice. The remaining portion of the Bear River Section will open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 8 until 6:00 p.m. Friday, July 10. That portion of the Three Hills Section located east of 159° 54.00' W long will be closed to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 8 until further notice. The remaining portion of the Three Hills Section will open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 8 until 6:00 p.m. Friday, July 10.

Salmon fishery announcements will be broadcast on VHF channel 72 daily at 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. and may also be obtained from ADF&G in Port Moller at 375-2716.
