

KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT # 10
For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-10-20

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Tuesday**, **July 21** to **9:00 p.m. Thursday**, **July 23** in the following areas:

- The Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay sections of the Alitak District.

As Previously Announced:

There will be an <u>81-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Monday**, **July 20** to **9:00 p.m. Thursday**, **July 23** in the following areas:

- The Outer Ayakulik, Halibut Bay, and Outer Karluk sections of the Southwest Kodiak District;
- The **Northwest Kodiak District** (except the Kizhuyak Bay, Terror Bay, Inner Uganik Bay, and Zachar Bay sections will remain closed);
- The **Afognak District** (except the Inner and Outer Kitoi Bay sections will remain closed);
- The Northeast Kodiak District;
- The Eastside Kodiak District (except the Inner Ugak Bay Section will remain closed); and,
- The **Humpy-Deadman Section** of the **Alitak District**.

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Monday**, **July 20** to **9:00 p.m. Wednesday**, **July 22** in the **Mainland District**.

The <u>Seaward Zones</u> of the Alinchak Bay, Katmai, Dakavak Bay, Outer Kukak Bay, Hallo Bay, and Big River sections of the <u>Mainland District</u> and the Seaward Zones of the <u>Northwest Afognak</u> and <u>Shuyak Island sections</u> of the <u>Afognak District</u> remain <u>closed</u> to commercial salmon fishing.

The following area remains **open until further notice**:

- The Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area (Telrod Cove).

<u>Until further notice</u>, in that portion of the Northwest Kodiak and Southwest Kodiak districts south of the latitude of Cape Kuliuk, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial salmon fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Concerning the North Shelikof Strait Fishery:

Short notice, inperiod closures may occur for seine fisheries in the Seaward Zones of the North Shelikof Strait area, as designated in the North Shelikof Strait Sockeye Salmon Management Plan (5 AAC 18.363). Closure announcements may occur at 8:30 a.m., 10:00 a.m., noon, 2:00 p.m., 5:00 p.m., or 8:00 p.m. on VHF channel 6.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office. Recent salmon fishery information may be obtained by calling the Department's 24-hour record-a-phone at 486-4559.
