Lower Cook Inlet Salmon Fishery Announcement #14

SOUTHERN DISTRICT: Purse seine- Waters of Tutka Bay Subdistrict northwest of a line between a point at 59° 28.22' N. Lat., 151° 27.85' W. Long., and another point at 59° 28.76' N. Lat., 151° 26.75' W. Long. (see Figure 1 at right) will open for a 16-hour fishing period at 6:00 AM on Monday, July 27 and remain open on a Monday, Wednesday, and Friday schedule of 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM fishing periods until further notice. Also beginning on July 27, the China Poot and Hazel Lake special harvest areas (SHA) are CLOSED to commercial common property harvest. In addition, effective at 6:00 AM on July 27, the Humpy Creek Subdistrict will open to common property harvest on a Monday, Wednesday, and Friday schedule of commercial purse seine fishing periods from 6:00 AM until 10:00 PM on those days.

The following areas remain open to commercial common property purse seine salmon harvest on a Monday, Wed., and Friday schedule of 16-hr fishing periods from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM,

-the Halibut Cove Subdistrict, excluding Halibut Cove Lagoon, -the China Poot Section, excluding the China Poot SHA, and -the Neptune Bay Section, excluding the Hazel Lake SHA.

Set gillnet- waters of the Southern District identified in 5AAC 21.330(b)(1) remain open to commercial set gillnet harvest on a regular schedule of two 48-hour fishing periods per week beginning at 6:00 AM on Mondays and Thursdays as defined in 5AAC 21.320(a)(3). Harvest from fishing periods to date is shown below in Table 1,

<u>OUTER DISTRICT</u>: Effective Monday, July 27 at 6:00 AM, waters of the Port Chatham Subdistrict are open on a Monday, Wednesday, and Friday schedule of 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM fishing periods. Also on this date, the Rocky Bay Subdistrict is closed until further notice.

The following areas remain open to commercial common property purse seine salmon harvest on a Monday, Wednesday, and Friday schedule of 16-hour fishing periods from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM,

-the Dogfish Bay Subdistrict,

-theWindy Bay Subdistrict,

as well as the Port Dick Middle, Head End, and Island Creek sections until further notice.

The Delight Lake weir was installed by Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association (CIAA) on July 2 and is being operated by CIAA staff. Through July 23, a total of 290 sockeye salmon had been counted. This is 3.9% of the minimum SEG of 7,500 fish.

KAMISHAK DISTRICT: The McNeil River Subdistrict, the Paint River Subdistrict, and Kirschner SHA remain closed to commercial salmon harvest until further notice. Other subdistricts of the Kamishak District as defined in 5AAC 21.299(e) remain open on a 7-days per week, 24-hour per day schedule. Waters of Chenik Lagoon east of 154° 08.33' W. long. remain open to commercial salmon harvest.

COVID-19: Under Alaska's Health Mandates 10, 17, and 18, commercial fishing is an Essential Business and

is part of Alaska's Essential Services and Critical Infrastructure. Commercial fishermen should ensure that all travel and other activities in support of commercial fishing operations follow protocols in Alaska COVID-19 Health Mandates.
