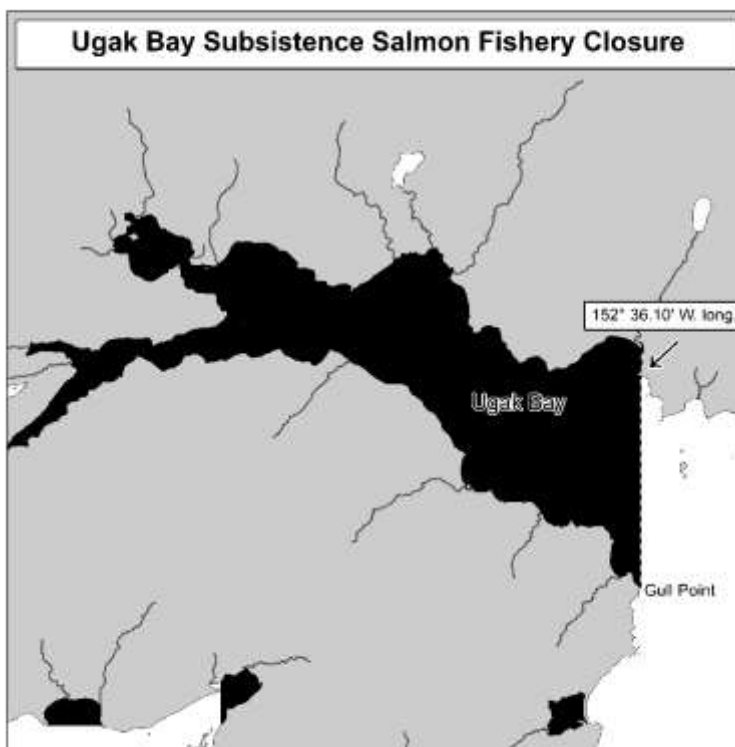

### KODIAK SUBSISTENCE SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT # 04 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-Sub-04-20

Closed waters for subsistence fishing in Ugak Bay will **increase until further notice** beginning at **12:01 a.m. Saturday August 1**, to all waters of Ugak Bay west of the longitude of Gull Point, 152°36.10' W long.



**As Previously Announced:**

Closed waters for subsistence fishing in Saltery Cove were **increased until further notice** beginning at **12:01 a.m. Saturday July 25**, to the normal closed waters, as described in regulation, northeast of a line from a point at 57°29.00' N lat. 152°43.29' W long. to a point at 57°29.79' N lat. 152°47.70' W long.

**Until Further notice**, Chinook (King Salmon) **may not be retained** in the subsistence fishery in the Karluk River drainage, including Karluk River Lagoon.

**Closed Water Adjustments**

Closed waters are currently **reduced** for subsistence fishing **until further notice** in the following locations:

- At Ouzinkie Harbor to the stream terminus of stream #259-396.
