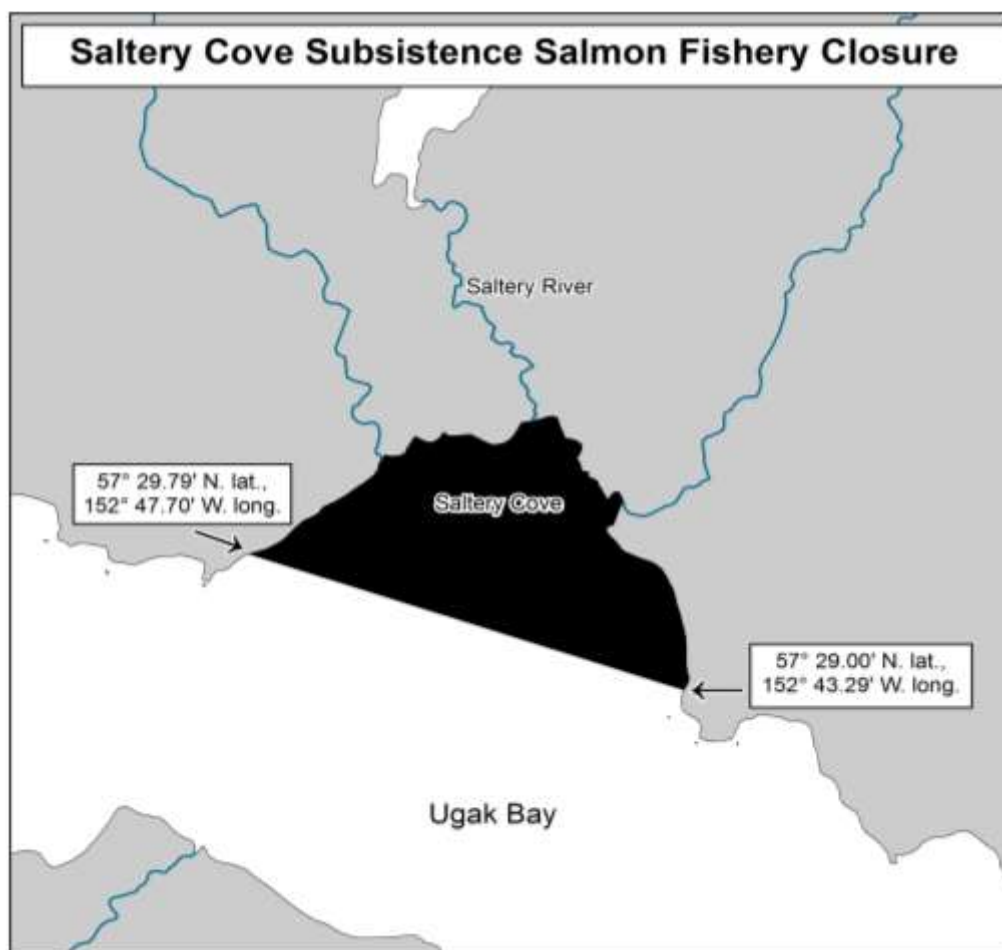

KODIAK SUBSISTENCE SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #05 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-Sub-05-20

Closed waters for subsistence fishing in Sallery Cove will be **reduced until further notice** beginning at **12:01 a.m. Sunday, August 9** to the normal closed waters, as described in regulation, northeast of a line from a point at 57°29.00' N lat. 152°43.29' W long. to a point at 57°29.79' N lat. 152°47.70' W long.



As Previously Announced:

Until further notice, Chinook (King Salmon) **may not be retained** in the subsistence fishery in the Karluk River drainage, including Karluk River Lagoon.

Closed Water Adjustments

Closed waters are currently **reduced** for subsistence fishing **until further notice** in the following location:

- At Ouzinkie Harbor to the stream terminus of stream #259-396.
