The Cinder River Section will open to commercial salmon fishing at 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 27 until 6:00 p.m. Saturday, July 31. Fishermen are reminded that only Cinder River Lagoon can open to commercial salmon fishing during June and July and is enclosed by a line across the lagoon entrance from 57° 21.14' N. lat., 158° 06.82' W. long. to 57° 21.46' N. lat., 158° 04.68' W. long.

The closed waters of Cinder River Lagoon upstream of a line from 57° 20.00' N. lat., 158° 08.02'W. long. to 57° 21.30' N. lat., 158° 02.63' W. long. are also closed to commercial salmon fishing.
