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Advisory Announcement
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**NORTHERN SOUTHEAST OUTSIDE (NSEO) SECTION LINGCOD BYCATCH
CLOSURE FOR SALMON TROLL FISHERY**

The retention of lingcod bycatch in the commercial salmon troll fishery **will close in the entire Northern Southeast Outside (NSEO) Section at 11:59 pm, Tuesday, July 12, 2022.** The 2022 NSEO salmon troll lingcod bycatch fishery guideline harvest level (GHL) is 3,200 round pounds. Based on reports from the grounds and harvest data to date, the department anticipates that the GHL will be taken by the time of the closure.

Lingcod bycatch in the salmon troll fishery remains open in the Icy Bay Subdistrict (IBS), East Yakutat (EYKT) Section, Central Southeast Outside (CSEO) Section, Southern Southeast Outer Coast (SSEOC) Sector, Northern Southeast Inside (NSEI) Subdistrict, and Southern Southeast Internal Waters (SSEIW) Sector. Lingcod catches will be closely monitored, and fishermen should expect additional area closures on short notice. Closure notices will be announced by ADF&G advisory announcement, United States Coast Guard marine broadcast, and the National Weather Service marine broadcast.
