## 2022 PORT ASUMCION TERMINAL HARVEST AREA FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The following information details the Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (SSRAA) Port Asumcion Terminal Harvest Area (THA) commercial fishing open waters and fishing schedule for the remainder of the 2022 season.

SSRAA has concluded cost recovery operations in the Port Asumcion THA for 2022. The Port Asumcion THA will **open for purse seine effective 6:00 a.m., Wednesday, August 31, 2022, until closed by emergency order at 11:59 p.m., September 15, 2022.** The Port Asumcion THA (103-55) consists of those waters of Port Asumcion north and west of a line from Point Cosinas at 55°21.80′ N lat, 133°30.64′ W long to a point west of Point Maria at 55°22.04′ N lat, 133°30.26′ W long.

<u>Chinook Salmon Landing Restrictions in the Port Asumcion THA</u>: Chinook salmon 28 inches or greater in length **MAY be retained and sold**. Chinook salmon less than 28 inches MAY be retained but not sold in the purse seine fishery. Chinook salmon 28 inches or greater harvested in the troll fishery may only be retained during those periods the summer troll fishery is open to retention of Chinook salmon.
