### **Port Moller Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #3** **Emergency Order #4-FS-M-PM-03-24**

The Bear River, Three Hills, and Outer Port Heiden Sections will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing. That portion of the Inik Section located southwest of a 300-degree bearing perpendicular to the beach at 159° 42.04' W. long. will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing until further notice. The remaining portion of the Inik Section will remain open to commercial salmon from 6:00 p.m. Saturday, June 22, until 6:00 p.m. Monday, June 24. The Port Moller Bight Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Saturday, June 22 until 6:00 p.m. Thursday, June 27.

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point, Cold Bay, and Port Moller Fish and Game offices.
