UPPER COOK INLET COMMERCIAL FISHING ANNOUNCEMENT No. 10 EMERGENCY ORDER NUMBER 2-F-H-13-24

Commercial salmon fishing in the Northern District of Upper Cook Inlet will be closed from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Monday, July 1, 2024.

The sustainable escapement goal (SEG) for king salmon in the Deshka River is 9,000 to 18,000 fish, as measured at the weir located at river mile seven. The Deshka River inseason projection suggest that the escapement goal is unlikely to be achieved. Through June 26, the king salmon passage through the Deshka River weir is 2,462 fish and on time to 3-days late projections estimate final escapement to be between 3,200 and 3,700 fish. Inseason information indicates king salmon run are exhibiting later run timings this year and fish are still likely present in the Northern District.
