## Sand Point Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #09 For Emergency Order #4-FS-M-SP-05-24

Due to the results of the July 5 test fishery of 8.3 immature salmon per set, the Shumagin Islands Section of the Southeastern District **WILL OPEN** to commercial salmon fishing by seine gear from 6:00 a.m. Saturday, July 6 until 3:00 p.m. Sunday, July 7, 2023.

Commercial salmon fishing by **purse seine and set gill gear** will be allowed for 33 hours from 6:00 a.m. Saturday, July 6 until 3:00 p.m. Sunday, July 7 in the following districts and sections:

Unimak District Southwestern District South Central District Shumagin Islands Section of the Southeastern District

Additionally, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the Unimak, Southwestern, South Central, and Southeastern districts of Area M during a commercial salmon fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Commercial salmon fishing by **drift gillnet gear** will be allowed for 33 hours from 6:00 a.m. Saturday, July 6 until 3:00 p.m. Sunday, July 7 in the following districts and sections:

Unimak District Ikatan Bay Section of the Southwestern District

All closed waters in the above locations will be as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.
