REVISED: Port Moller Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #11 **Emergency Order #4-FS-M-PM-11-24**

The Ilnik Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Thursday, July 11, until 6:00 p.m. Sunday, July 14. The Port Moller Bight Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Thursday, July 11, until 6:00 p.m. Sunday, July 14. The Cinder River Section will open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 9, until 6:00 p.m. Sunday, July 14. As a reminder, as per regulation only the waters within Cinder River Lagoon (Shagong Lagoon) are open to commercial salmon fishing within the Cinder River Section until August 1 (5 AAC 09.310(a)(1)).

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point, Cold Bay, and Port Moller Fish and Game offices.
