KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #29 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-29-24

There will be a **78-hour** commercial salmon fishing period in the **Inner Karluk Section** of the **Southwest Kodiak District** from **noon Monday, September 2 to 6:00 p.m. Thursday, September 5.**

There will be a **48-hour extension** to the current commercial salmon fishing period from **6:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 3 to 6:00 p.m. Thursday, September 5** in the following areas:

- The **Halibut Bay, Sturgeon, and Outer Karluk Sections** of the **Southwest Kodiak District**; and
- The **Southwest Afognak Section** of the **Afognak District.**

The current commercial salmon fishing period in the **Central and North Cape Sections** of the **Northwest Kodiak District** will be extended to remain **open until further notice.**

Closed water adjustment:

Closed waters will be **reduced** from **noon Monday, September 2 to 6:00 p.m. Thursday, September 5** in the following area:

- At Karluk Lagoon's exit channel terminus at the ocean shoreline (stream #255-101)

As previously announced:

There will be a **54-hour** commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Sunday, September 1 to 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 3** in the following areas:

- The **Monashka-Mill Bay Section** of the **Northeast Kodiak District**;
- The **Inner Uganik Bay Section** of the **Northwest Kodiak District**;
- The **Eastside Kodiak District**; and
- The **Humpy-Deadman Section** of the **Alitak District.**

There will be a **24-hour extension** to the current commercial salmon fishing period from **6:00 p.m. Monday, September 2 to 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 3** in the following areas:

- The **Inner Upper Station and Outer Upper Station Sections** of the **Alitak District**;

The following areas remain **open** to commercial salmon fishing **until further notice:**

- The **Cape Alitak, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections** of the **Alitak District.**

Closed Water Adjustments:

Closed waters are **reduced** until **6:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 3** in the **Inner Upper Station Section** of the **Alitak District** to the stream terminus of Olga Creek (stream #257-304).

Closed waters are **expanded until further notice** in that portion in the **Southwest Afognak Section** of the **Afognak District** to within one-half nautical mile of the beach near the terminus of Malina Creek (stream #251-105) between 58° 10.00' N lat. and 58° 11.00' N lat.

Until further notice, in the **Kodiak Area (including the Mainland District)** **Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear** in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office.
