#### EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state of Alaska resident and nonresident mountain goat hunting season in the Mt. Kluchman portion of the RG013 hunt area. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Wednesday, September 13, 2023.

#### REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting mountain goats in Unit 1(C):

Remainder of Unit 1(C), that portion west of the US/Canada Border to East Twin Glacier, And north of the Taku River; Commonly referred to as Mt. Kluchman.

1 goat by registration permit only, the taking of nannies with kids is prohibited 1 Aug. – 13 Sept. (General hunt only)

1 Aug. – 13 Sept.

The remainder of Unit 1(C) mountain goat seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

#### JUSTIFICATION:

Based on our last survey information, this area can support a harvest of 1-2 goat points (male goat = 1 point & female goat = 2 points) that was established for this portion of the RG013 hunt area. As of September 12, 2023, 2 billies were harvested from this area and the guideline harvest for this area has been met. Thus, the area is being closed by Emergency Order effective at 11:59 pm, Wednesday, September 13, 2023.
