Unit 20/25C Moose Hunters

Important regulation changes starting in the 2024 season


General season moose harvest permits are no longer valid in Units 20A, 20B, 20C, 20D, 20F, and 25C.


The registration permits RM781 and RM749 replace all general season moose hunts previously covered by harvest ticket (GM000) in these units.

Hunters in Units 20A, 20B, 20C, 20F, and 25C must have an **RM781**permit.

Hunters in Unit 20D must have an RM749 permit.

Registration permits are printed on white paper and the permit number is located in the top right corner. See example below







All registration permit report cards must be submitted within 15 days of a kill. Unsuccessful hunters and those who did not hunt must report within 15 days after the close of the season.

If you fail to report, you will not be eligible to receive any permits (Drawing, Targeted, Tier II, or Registration, including Tier I Nelchina Caribou) during the next regulatory year. In addition, your name will be turned over to the Alaska Wildlife Troopers for enforcement action.

Available online starting July 1, and at ADF&G offices in Fairbanks, Delta and Tok, and in the communities of Minto, Tanana, Nenana, and Central.
