Ship Creek Moose Hunt Closes

(Anchorage) – Registration permit hunt RM435 for bull moose in the Ship Creek drainage will close at 11:59 PM on Sunday, November 8, 2020, by Emergency Order of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game. As of November 6, five bull moose have been taken during the registration season and additional hunters remain in the field. Nine bulls were taken in the same area during the drawing hunts in September from a population of about 200 animals. The harvest of 15 bulls is consistent with the goal of maintaining appropriate bull:cow ratios and population levels in this hunt area, therefore no further harvest is warranted at this time.

The hunt area includes the Ship Creek drainage in Unit 14C. All other moose hunts in Unit 14 are unaffected by this emergency order.
