Permits Available July 7 for Kenai Peninsula Registration Goat Hunt RG365

(Homer) – Permits for mountain goat registration hunt RG365 in Game Management Unit 15 will be available starting July 7 in the local communities of Port Graham and Nanwalek, and the Homer Area Office. A limited number of permits will be distributed from each location. Permits in Port Graham will be available from the Tribal Council Office, and in Nanwalek from the IRA Council.

Permits must be picked up in person and will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis.

RG365 is open to Alaska resident and nonresident hunters. Twenty-one permits will be issued for the hunt.
