Responsibilities:

To plan and facilitate 1 - 2 Project WILD/AWC workshops within the first year after attending a facilitator training workshop. Workshop audience size must be 10 participants or more, comprised primarily of teachers and other educators. Workshops are 8 hours in length.

- ◇ Experience in environmental education
- ◇ Presentation/speaking experience
- ◇ Familiarity with Alaska wildlife and ecosystems
- ◇ Familiarity with multi-cultural education and Alaska native cultures
- ◇ Willingness to travel
- ◇ Flexibility
- ◇ Strong communication skills
- ◇ Bachelor's degree in education, natural resource management or related field

Evaluation:

The primary purpose of evaluation is to improve the quality of workshop experiences for educators. Facilitators will complete a facilitator self-evaluation form after each workshop that will be reviewed by the Coordinator. This review will be followed by a phone conversation reviewing possible changes for the future.
