Acknowledgement:

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) manages the Juneau Hunter Education Facility and Indoor Shooting Range (JHEF) and administers the Hunter Education (HE) Program that includes a wide variety of activities, i.e. basic (firearms and bow) classes, advanced modules, and clinics. Volunteer Fellows assist the staff with the administrative and operational needs of the Hunter Information and Training (HIT) Program and the JHEF, located at 5670 Montana Creek Rd, Juneau, AK (mailing address: PO Box 35813, Juneau, AK 99803).

Purpose: This document establishes the requirements and process to apply for a team position on the JHEF bullseye target pistol league.

Scope: Any individual age 12 years or older, who has not been convicted of misdemeanor crime of domestic violence within the meaning of Title 18 U.S.C. section 921(a)(33)(A).

Responsibilities: Each competitor is held to the following performance standards:

- Pay the fees.
- Follow the Live-fire Range, Competition, and CMP rules.
- Conduct yourself in a safe and responsible manner at all times.
- Communicate with team members and alternates.
- Possess safe and fully operating firearms, adequate ammunition, and necessary supplies to participate during each match.

Procedure: Approval of applications and recognition of competitor status is at the discretion of ADF&G. The minimum requirements for approval are to:

- Complete and submit a league packet (application and firearms possession inquiry). Pay the entry fee, as a minimum, or league fee.

Instructions:
