The Alaska Department of Fish and Game invites the public to share information and concerns about the Kachemak Bay and Fox River Flats Critical Habitat Areas (CHAs). This is the first step in ADF&G's effort to revise the management plan for Kachemak Bay and Fox River Flats CHAs.

We would like to know how you use the area and its resources, and are looking for ideas on how to manage activities and public uses that are compatible with the CHA's mission to protect fish, wildlife, and their habitats.

Some issues that have been addressed in the previous Management Plan are: public access, motorized vehicle use, shoreline alterations, floating structures, commercial uses, public facilities, long term anchorage, buoys and running lines, docks, mining, utility lines, grazing, gear and boat storage, and aquatic farming projects.
