

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

MEETING ON THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF A PRIVATE NONPROFIT HATCHERY PERMIT FOR NORTHERN SOUTHEAST REGIONAL AQUACULTURE ASSOCIATION PROPOSED LITTLE PORT WALTER HATCHERY

The Commissioner of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game is holding a public meeting (in accordance with Alaska Statutes 16.10.400-16.10.480) for the purpose of taking public comment on the issuance of a private nonprofit hatchery permit to Northern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (NSRAA) for operation of the Little Port Walter Hatchery. The hatchery will be located at the site of the Little Port Walter Research Facility on Baranof Island, Alaska, and will produce Chinook salmon.

The meeting will be held at the NSRAA Conference Room, 1308 Sawmill Creek Road, in Sitka, AK on **April 9, 2024.** The hearing will start at 6:00 PM and end at 9:00 PM or earlier if adjourned.
