

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE  
ALASKA BOARD OF FISHERIES**

Notice is given that the Alaska Board of Fisheries (board) will meet by teleconference on November 1, 2006, beginning at 2:30 p.m. The purpose of the teleconference is to consider generating a proposal to modify the start date of the Aleutian Islands District pollock fishery.

At its recent meeting in October 2006, the board adopted a new regulation providing for a state waters pollock fishery in the Adak area. New information from the North Pacific Fishery Management Council's Steller Sea Lion Mitigation Committee has prompted to board to consider generating a proposal to modify the start date of the fishery for consideration during its December 2006 regulatory meeting.

This request may be considered under the board's Policy for Changing Board Agenda (5 AAC 39.999(b)) in order to coordinate state regulatory actions with federal fishery agencies, programs, or laws.
