It was just recently brought to my attention that there will be a vote tomorrow to move the 2020 Cook Inlet Finfish Meeting of the Board of Fisheries from Anchorage to Soldotna. I strongly urge the board not to make this move. As you are aware, many of the stocks of concern are in the Mat-Su Valley and I believe that moving the location of the meeting will not give my constituents an opportunity to be involved in the decision making process for these waters. My constituents, as well as the constituents of my colleagues in the Mat-Su, will be disenfranchised by such a move by the Board. Please keep the meeting in Anchorage and allow the Mat-Su shareholders an opportunity to listen and voice their concerns.
