RE: Comments on March 8 Board of Fisheries Hatchery Committee tentative agenda (RC 11)

Dear Chairman Morisky and Alaska Board of Fisheries Members:

Thank you for requesting agenda item recommendations for the board's Hatchery Committee meeting scheduled for March 8, 2019.

Silver Bay Seafoods remains supportive of the board's intent to provide opportunity for the public and board members alike to develop an informed understanding on management, production, and research relating to Alaska's salmon fishery enhancement program. However, given the timeline of these current efforts and the proposed structure of the board's tentative Hatchery Committee agenda (RC 11), and especially the afternoon's proposed "Open Forum," we are concerned about the resulting quality of input available to the board in such a setting. In particular, the proposed topics of "hatchery stock straying" and "enhancement related research" are arguably best addressed by individuals who have devoted their academic and professional careers to these highly complex issues. As these individuals' time and expertise are highly sought after, we have doubts that this process will result in their attendance on March 8.

With the intent of encouraging board member access to high-quality presentations of research relating to these issues, Silver Bay Seafoods recommends that Alaska Board of Fisheries members consider attending the following upcoming meetings:
