I submitted proposal 175, I would like to amend the proposed new language to more closely mirror what is in regulation now,

Fishing seasons.

In 5 AAC 21.310. (ii)

....; on or after JULY 1, when the Kasilof Section is open to commercial fishing with set gillnets and the Kenai and East Forelands sections are closed to commercial fishing with set gillnets, commercial fishing with set gillnets may be allowed within 600 feet of the mean high tide mark in that portion of the Kenai Section north of the latitude of the Blanchard Line at 60 degrees 27.10 minutes N. lat., and south of the latitude of the ADF&G regulatory marker located south of the Kenai River mouth at 60 degrees 30.49 minutes N lat.;
