**RE: POW Subsistence Dungeness Harvest Data**

Hi Kurt,

Per your request, the following data details the subsistence Dungeness harvest data collected by the Division of Subsistence during household harvest surveys on Prince of Wales.

Most of the community data we have is relatively old, having been collected in the mid 1990s. We have not had funding to update comprehensive subsistence harvest information for most Southeast communities since then.

In 2013 and 2014, we received funding from the legislature to update Southeast communities and we were able to survey 6 – Hydaburg and Whale Pass on POWI, as well as Haines, Angoon, Hoonah, and Sitka.
