Substitute language for proposal #31 :

5 AAC 06.377 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(c) A SO3T or S04T CFEC permit holder must report on a form provided by the department the total number of king salmon retained for personal use that were harvested in a commercial fishery annually as follows:

(1) CFEC permit number

(2) statistical area of harvest

(3) the permanent ADF&G vessel license plate number; if applicable

(4) date of harvest;

(5) number of king salmon greater than 28 inches in length;

(6) number of king salmon between 20 and 28 inches in length;

(7) the form must be submitted to the department no later than November <u>30th by the method specified on the form provided by the department.</u>

5 AAC 67.022(g) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(g) In the Nushagak River drainage, excluding the Wood River drainage, and unless otherwise specified in 5 AAC 06.361 or 5 AAC 06.368, the following special provisions apply:

(7) a harvest report for the total number of king salmon harvested in the Nushagak River drainage is required to be submitted to the department in the manner specified by the department no later than November 30th containing the following information:

(A)number of king salmon harvested;

(B) number of king salmon released;

(C) number of king salmon harvested greater than 28 inches in

length;

(D) number of king salmon harvested between 20 and 28 inches in

length;
