

Miscellaneous Business

- 1. The board added one day to the March 2023, meeting on Statewide Finfish and Supplemental Issues to accommodate Proposals 11–13 and the Nushagak River Chinook Salmon Action Plan, which were deferred. New meeting dates: March 10–14, 2023 (Egan Center, Anchorage).
- 2. Discussion about the need for increased fishery enforcement funding was referred to the board's Legislation Committee to develop recommendations to be brought back to the full board for consideration at a future meeting.
- 3. Member Mitchell provided the board with an update on the newly formed UAF/UAS Master of Marine Policy program.
- 4. The board discussed whether there is a need to continue the Committee on Naknek River Sport Commercial Services/Guide Fisheries. No decision reached; board Chair will take it under advisement and welcomes additional public input on the matter.
