





#### **Yakutat**

Includes the community of Yakutat

#### **Haines**

Includes the communities of Haines, Klukwan, and Skagway

#### Juneau

Includes the communities of Juneau, Angoon, Hoonah, Tenakee Springs, Gustavus, Pelican, and Elfin Cove

#### Sitka

Includes the communities of Sitka and Port Alexander

#### Petersburg/Wrangell

Includes the communities of Petersburg, Wrangell, and Kake

#### Ketchikan

Includes all POW communities, Ketchikan, and Metlakatla

## "when the tide is out, the table is set"

- Wide diversity of species used
- Harvest timing:
  - Late fall through winter
  - Year-round
- Methods: Pots, rings, rakes, spears, digging implements
- Preservation: eaten fresh, dried, frozen, canned
- Sharing is important













# MARINE INVERTEBRATE SEARCH AND HARVEST AREAS 14






## HARVEST COMPOSITION




## HARVEST AND USE OF MARINE INVERTEBRATES
