5 AAC 92.011. Taking of game by proxy. (a) A resident hunter (the proxy) holding a valid resident hunting license may take only moose, caribou, and deer for another resident (the beneficiary) who is blind, physically disabled, or 65 years of age or older, as authorized by <u>AS 16.05.405</u>. A person participating in a proxy hunt, except hunts requiring that complete antlers and skull plates be submitted to the department, must remove at least one antler from the skull plate or cut the skull plate in half (on anterled animals) for both the proxy's animal and the benficiary's animal before leaving the kill site.

- (2) In addition, proxy hunting is prohibited in the following hunts because use of the proxy would allow circumvention of harvest restrictions specified by the board.
 - (A) Unit 20(E) moose and caribou registration hunts (RM865 and RC860 and RC867)
 - (B) Units 21 and 24 moose registration hunts (RM832 and RM834) if you hold a drawing permit for the Galena area
 - (C) Units 9(A), 9(B), 9(C), that portion within the Alagnak River drainage, 17(B), 17(C), 18, 19(A), and 19(B) caribou hunts from August 1 October 31.
 - (D) Unit 5(A) Youth Management Area
- **5 AAC 92.530. Management areas.** The following management areas are subject to special restrictions

- (27) the Yakutat Youth Hunt Management Area:
 - (A) Unit 5A;
- (B) the area is open to deer hunting by a child aged 10 to 17 who has successfully completed a department-approved hunter education class who is accompanied by an adult who is an accompanied by an licensed resident adult 21 years of age or older;
