John pointed out that Sitka is a subsistence community and boundaries are not black and white as to where activities occur. Randy commented that antlerless hunts generally represent surplus animals. The surplus animals should be available to those with "local knowledge". Tad pointed out that numerous Sitkans hunt Unit 3 and that Gustavus was never discussed much in the past, which he believes is an indicator that not many Sitkans hunt Gusvatus. McCracken does not like it; stating that we view our citizens as using many of the adjacent areas in the historic past and that we have valuable knowledge and interest in those areas. Amend the proposal that we should have save in antlerless moose hunts in Unit 16B Kalgin Island, 6D, and 15 A, B, and C. Casey would like to vote the whole of 175 down as he believes each AC should vote on what is important to its members and those they represent. He feels we do not abuse the system by taking positions on matters not relevant to us. Hatch said we represent many groups of hunters in our area an should be able to give input in many areas. Foldager did like the idea that we would be limited in our discussions and should be able to give input on what we felt was important to us. Similar comment came from White. Some feared this would be a precedent for restricting the input of ACs on other matters to specific local issues. Hatch see input possible by any AC but believes for the Board to ac ton antlerless hunts it must have the support of the local Ac specifically involved with the hunt in questions. He and others expressed sympathy for local jurisdiction and the folks most impacted. Amendment passed 9-1-0. Discussion on the main motion: Similar to above but focus was on the historic involvement by Seward area hunters and the knowledge Seward hunters have of adjacent areas. The idea of cow hunting was not endorsed by some of the opponents.</p>

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Anchorage AC - AC 01	6-9, 11, 13-16 & 19	14C	Support w/am	<p>As written, our AC is unanimously opposed to this proposal. AS of 2012 the Anchorage AC represents close to 25,000 licensed hunters. They make up a large percentage of hunters in many HMU's other than Unit 14. We feel that the Anchorage AC should have its input heard on the reauthorization of antlerless moose hunts in Units that fall under the description in 5AAC 97.005, which lays out which AC's have jurisdiction regarding emergency closures of F&G during established seasons. These Units for the Anchorage AC are Units 6-9, 11, 13-16 and 19. While not all of these Units currently have antlerless moose hunts, it does clarify all possible areas of jurisdiction. As an example in Unit 13 Anchorage hunters made up 40% of the moose hunters. In Unit 16, over 28%. In Unit 15, it was 5.5%, most likely due to the current low numbers of moose on the Kenai Peninsula. It is interesting to note that the Anchorage hunters made up only 27% of the moose hunters in Unit 14, where the Anchorage AC has jurisdiction, and in Units 13, and 16 where we have higher percentage of hunters participating into eh moose hunters there is not jurisdiction for the Anchorage AC. The Anchorage AC amended this proposal to include all Units it has jurisdiction under 5AAC 97.005, to extend the same jurisdiction to 98.005. Support 14, opposed 0. The Anchorage AC unanimously supported this amendment to extend the same jurisdiction for the reauthorization of antlerless moose in 5AAC 98.005. Other solutions considered: If the Department of Law continues to insist that ACs must be physically located in the GMU to have the authority to authorize antlerless hunts, then the board should recommend an amendment to AS16.05.780 adding some language for jurisdiction based on a certain percentage of moose hunters in any GMU represented by an AC. Suggestion of that percentage ranged from 5 to 10 percent.</p>

Bill wants AC to stick to local areas. Dan sees some of the language as more expansive allowing our AC vote to mean something in other GMU's if we so please. Mel Grove mentioned wanting to have a say in Unit 20A because that is where he hunts. Mel thought ACs should be allowed to vote depending upon how many participants - perhaps more than 10% of the hunters in an area. Andy Couch amended the motion to provide Mat Valley AC jurisdiction over antlerless moose hunts in all subunits 13, 14, and 16. Amendment passes 10-3-0. Minority comment we could be getting other ACs commenting on our areas which could be trouble. Other members felt we should comment on other areas. Mel moved for a 2nd amendment that ACs with a 10% constituent hunter use in any specific GMU or subunit be allowed jurisdiction as well. Rick 2nd. Frank mentioned that Anchorage AC has jurisdiction over all types of game in some units but not for antlerless moose hunts 2nd amendment to motion failed 3-9-1. As previously amended to give Mat Valley AC jurisdiction over antlerless moose huts in all subunits of Units 13, 14, and 16; motion passed. 10-3-0.

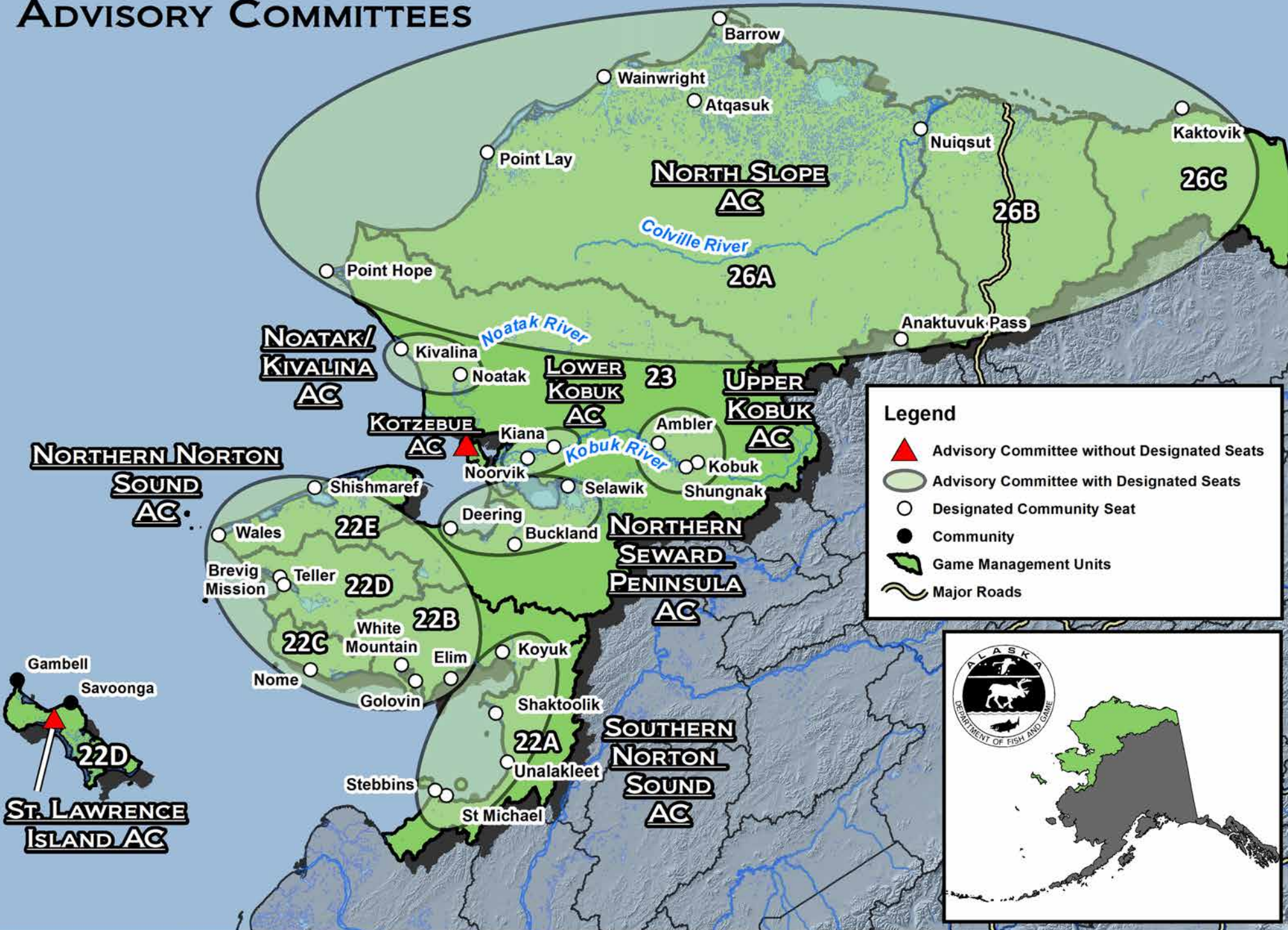

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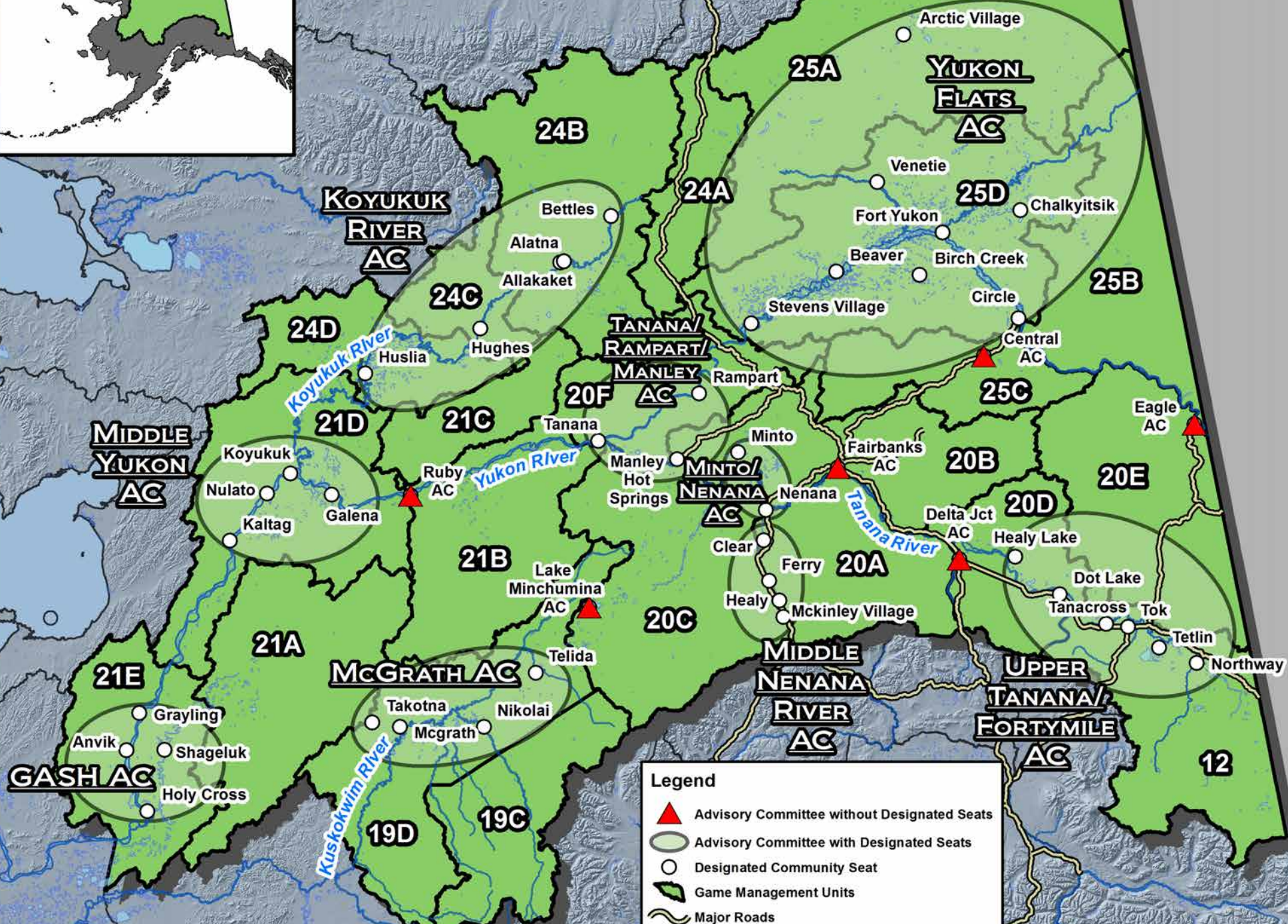

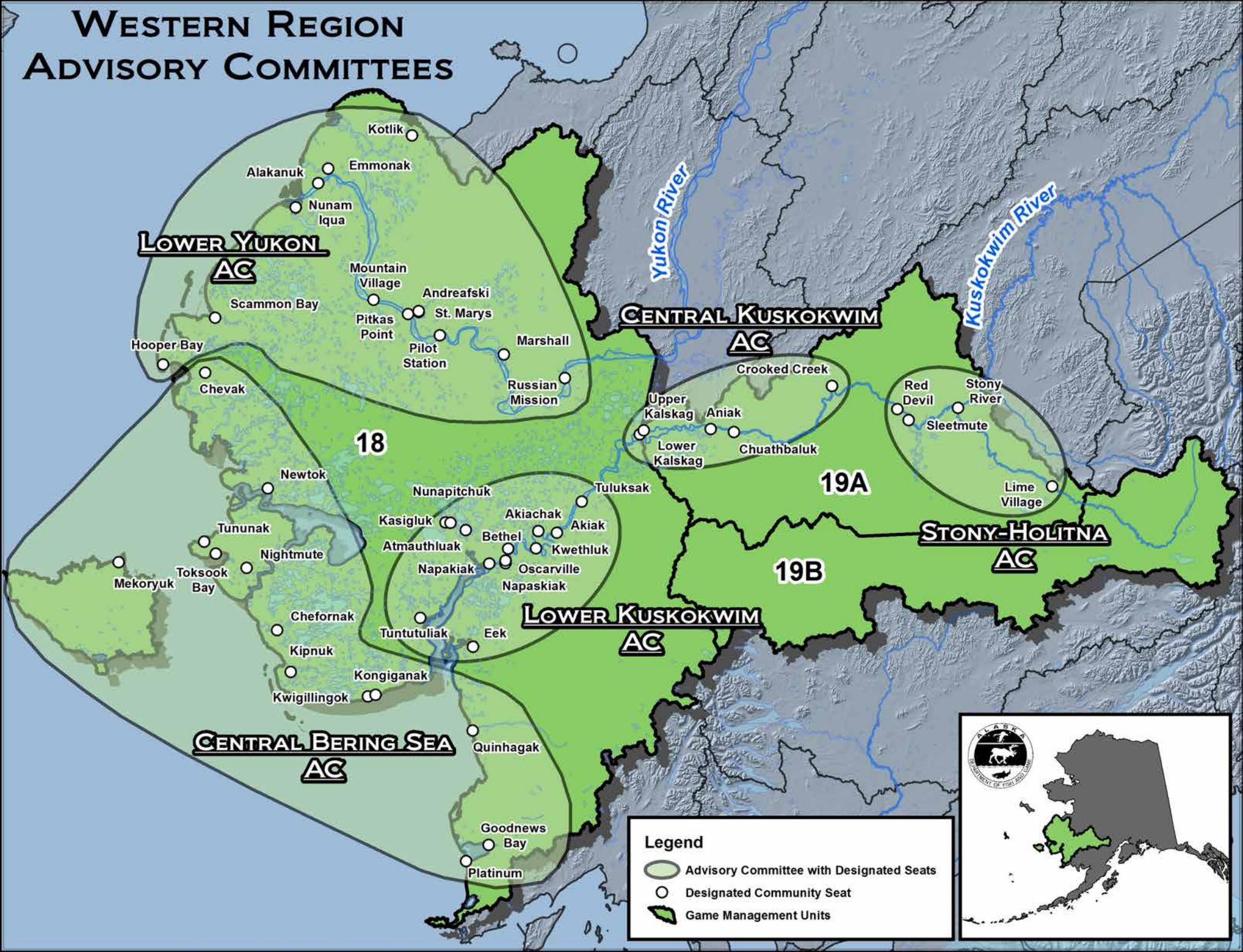
INTERIOR REGION ADVISORY COMMITTEES

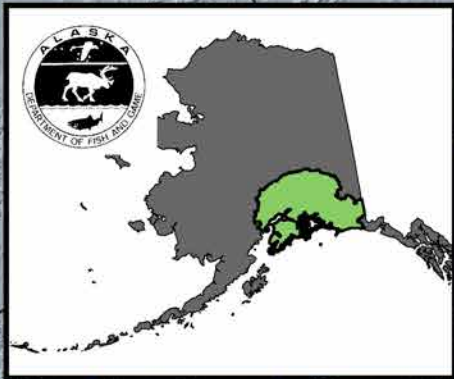
WESTERN REGION ADVISORY COMMITTEES

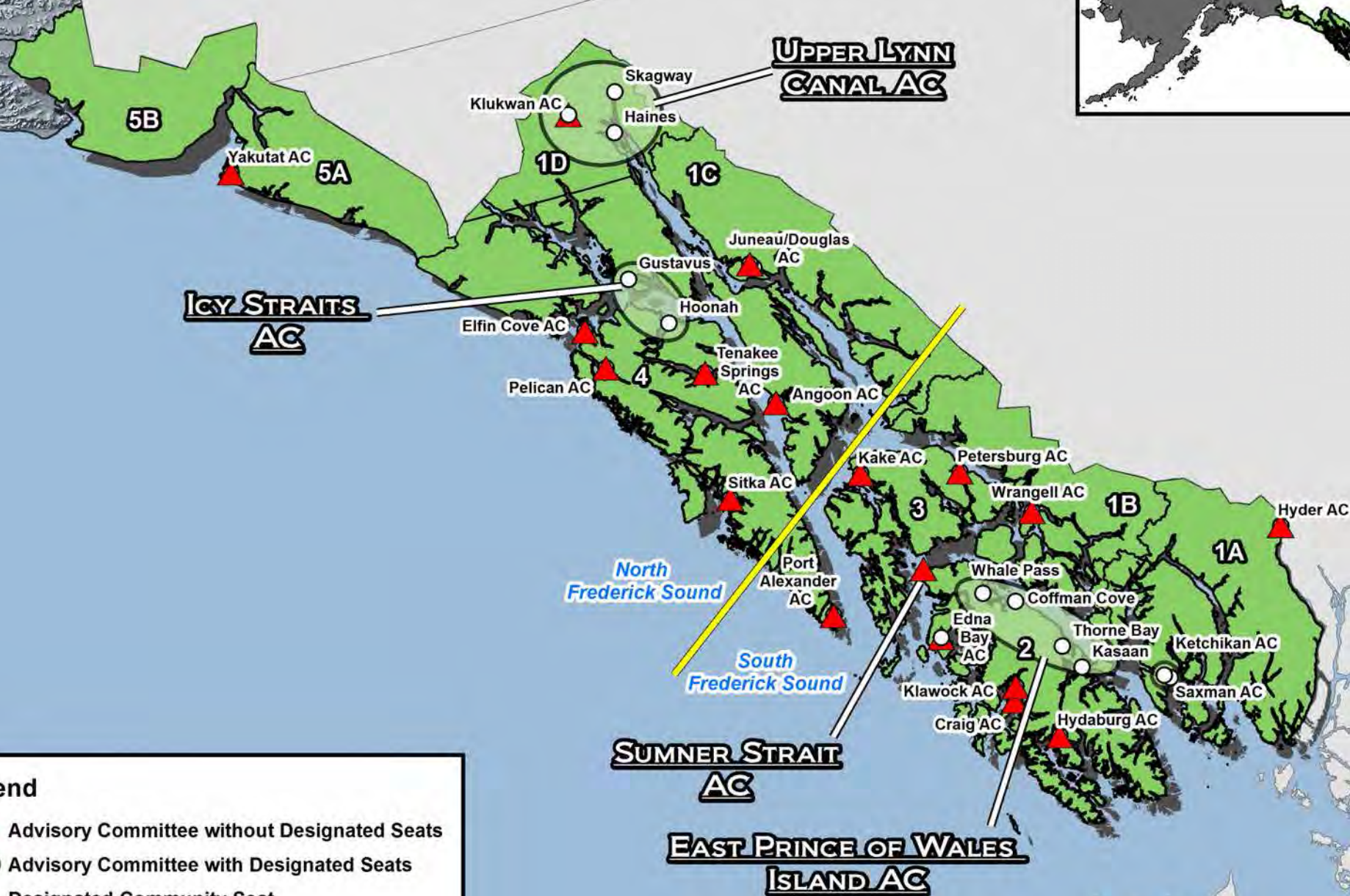
