# Dall Sheep Ram Evaluation by ADF&G, Division of Wildlife Conservation

## **ISSUE:**

Hunters, ADF&G staff, Wildlife Troopers and others are concerned with the lack of consistent methods and standards used to determine if Dall rams are legal at the time of sealing.

#### **ACTION:**

Division of Wildlife Conservation staff have formed a team of educators, biologists, and front line staff that is currently editing a Dall sheep guide for evaluating Dall rams to determine if they are legal. The standards covered in this document will address how to determine full-curl based on three methods, how to age rams based on horn rings, and how to more clearly understand and determine what a "broken" horn is. This document will be reviewed by other staff, Alaska Wildlife Troopers, user groups, and others with the intent to eventually produce education and training materials for hunters, guides, staff, and wildlife troopers.

#### Goals:

- 1) Reduce frustration between hunters and ADF&G staff evaluating legal sheep at sealing
- 2) Provide education materials and training opportunities for hunters, guides, and others

#### TIMELINE:

January Dall sheep ram evaluation team finalizes edits Dall sheep guide

February Review and editing by MCT, DMT, staff, and user input as appropriate

March Report to the BOG and BGCSB on progress and plans for implementation

April – June Share information, distribute sheep guide, provide training to ADF&G and AWT staff

July Provide workshops on evaluating rams to educate sheep hunters, guides, and others
