5 AAC 85.045. Hunting seasons and bag limits for moose.

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM YOU WOULD LIKE THE BOARD TO ADDRESS? STATE IN DETAIL THE NATURE OF THE CURRENT PROBLEM. I am requesting a change in the State of Alaska hunting regulations for the benefit of a special group of disabled veterans. This group is 100% service connected disabled, with a purple heart and receiving special monthly compensation (SMC) from the Veterans Affairs. SMC is payment for loss of or use of a hand or foot, etcetera.

WHAT SOLUTION DO YOU PREFER? I propose those meeting the criteria be allowed to hunt moose under the following guidelines.

For resident veterans only:

In any area with a healthy moose population, bull/cow ratio, qualified veterans would be allowed to harvest any moose, with the exception of calf or cow with calf/calves.

In an area with a poor balance/ratio of bull to cow or vise-versa, the individual would be able to harvest whichever sex ADF&G deemed to be best/proper.

No antler restrictions would apply.

Qualified veterans must be 100% service connected disabled, with a purple heart "and" receiving special monthly compensation (SMC) from Veterans Affairs.

Proxy hunting for these individuals would not be allowed.
