 - 1 individual won twice

Proposal 21

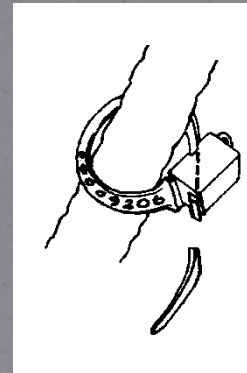
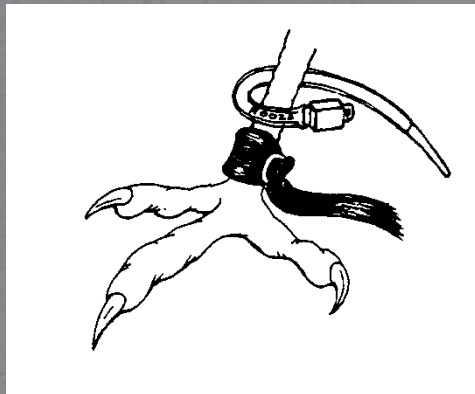
- Provides additional identification

- 4 species require bands
 - Microchips only required when band is lost

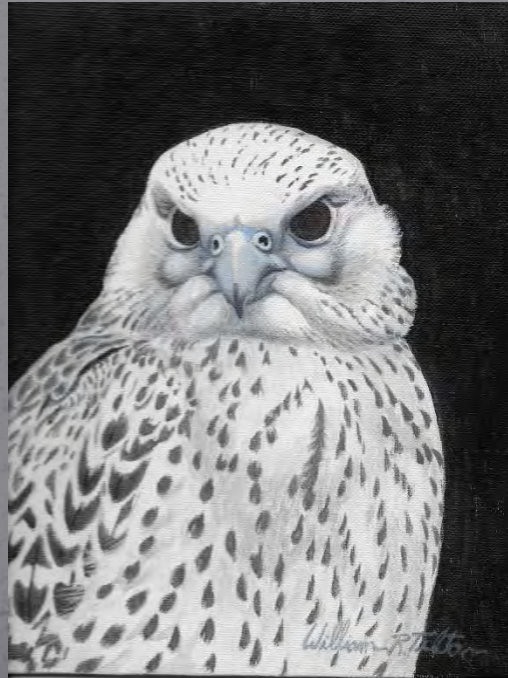
